## ELEVENTH SUNDAY ORDINARY TIME A, JESUS SENDING HIS DISCIPLES

The Gospel begins with a beautiful statement: "At the sight of the crowds, Jesus' heart was moved with compassion for them, because they were troubled and abandoned, like sheep without a shepherd."

If God were to ask me, "*What virtue would you like to receive?*" I would answer without hesitation: compassion. Everything Jesus did flowed from His compassionate heart. He fed the hungry, healed the sick, forgave sinners, welcomed outcasts, and comforted the suffering—all because He was moved with compassion.

The word compassion comes from the Latin COM & PASSIO meaning "to suffer with." It is not merely feeling sorry for someone; it is entering into another person's pain and carrying it with love. A compassionate person does not rush to judge or criticize. Instead, he asks, "*What happened to this person? Why is she acting this way? What burden is he carrying?*" Compassion changes our perspective. We stop seeing people as problems and begin seeing them as brothers and sisters loved by God. A young boy was carrying his younger brother on his back. The younger brother was crippled and could not walk. As the boy climbed a steep hill, a man watching him felt sorry and asked, "Son, isn't that a heavy burden for you?"

The boy immediately replied with a smile, "Burden? No, sir. He is not a burden. He is my brother." The man was deeply moved. The weight on the boy's shoulders had not changed, but his perspective changed everything. Love transformed the burden into a privilege.

When someone belongs to us, we do not quickly condemn them. We try to understand them. This is how Jesus looked at the crowds. He saw beyond their faults and recognized their deep need for love, guidance, and healing.

Jesus then tells His disciples: "The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few. Ask the master of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest." The first qualification for a laborer in God's vineyard is not talent, education, or success. It is a compassionate heart. A heart that sees as Jesus sees and loves as Jesus loves.

### **Christ Gives Authority Over Evil**

Jesus summons the Twelve Apostles and gives them authority over unclean spirits and over every disease and illness. The names of the Apostles are listed one by one, reminding us that Christ entrusts real people with His mission and His power.

What does this authority over unclean spirits mean? As Catholics, we believe that evil is not merely an idea or a symbol. Satan and demonic spirits are real. Jesus Himself repeatedly confronted and cast out demons during His public ministry. If we believe in Jesus and the Gospel, we cannot simply dismiss the reality of evil spirits. In the Lord's Prayer, Jesus taught us to pray, "Deliver us from evil." He would not teach us this prayer if evil were not real.

At the same time, we should not become obsessed with demons or imagine that every problem is caused by them. The Church teaches that Christ is infinitely more powerful than Satan. The focus of the Gospel is not the power of evil but the victory of Christ over evil.

The ordinary battle against evil takes place in our hearts every day. Whenever we give in to hatred, jealousy, resentment, gossip, pride, judgment, or selfishness, we allow the spirit of evil to influence our thoughts and actions. Whenever we choose forgiveness, kindness, humility, truth, and love, we allow the Holy Spirit to guide us. Therefore, the question is not whether evil exists; the question is: Which spirit is guiding my life today? Is it the Spirit of Christ, leading me to compassion, mercy, and holiness? Or am I allowing negativity, anger, and selfishness to take control?

The good news of today's Gospel is that Jesus has given His Church the power to overcome evil. Through prayer, the sacraments, the Word of God, and a life of faith, we can live in the freedom of the children of God. Let us ask the Lord today: "Jesus, protect me from evil and fill me with Your Holy Spirit."

### **Start with the "Israel" God has given you**

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells the apostles: "*Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel.*" At first glance, this sounds surprising. Why not send them immediately to everyone? Later, after the Resurrection, Jesus will indeed command them to go to all nations. But first, He sends them to their own people.

There is a lesson here for us. In every life there is a known area and an unknown area. Before trying to change the whole world, God asks us to begin with the people closest to us: our family, our relatives, our neighbors, our workplace, our parish. That is our "Israel." Sometimes we are eager to correct strangers while neglecting those whom God has already entrusted to our care. Jesus says: start where you are. Be a witness of faith, kindness, forgiveness, and charity in your own circle first.

There is another lesson. Jesus tells them not to enter Samaritan territory at this stage. Spiritually, this reminds us not to rush into judging situations we do not understand. Many times we criticize people without knowing their struggles, wounds, or circumstances. We enter territories that we do not know.

Before judging others, we must learn humility. Only God sees the whole picture. Instead of criticism, let us offer understanding; instead of condemnation, let us offer prayer.

When the apostles were faithful to their mission in Israel, Jesus later entrusted them with the whole world. The same is true for us. If we are faithful in the small circle God has given us today, He will open wider doors tomorrow.

So let us ask ourselves: Who are the "lost sheep" in my own Israel—my family, my community, my workplace? Perhaps Jesus is sending me to them first. Before reaching the ends of the earth, let me begin with the people God has already placed in my life. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus, overflowing with mercy and compassion, transform our hearts. May we learn to see every person as Jesus sees them and become instruments of His love in the world. **Amen.**

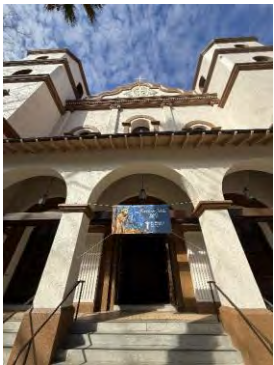

## Jubilee Year of St. Francis of Assisi

The Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, has proclaimed a Special Jubilee Year of Saint Francis of Assisi. The year takes place from January 10, 2026 to January 10, 2027, commemorating the 800th anniversary of the death of our beloved St. Francis. St. Francis was born Giovanni di Pietro di Bernardone in 1182 or 1183 and he was an Italian mystic, poet, and Catholic friar who founded the religious order of the Franciscans.



During this blessed Jubilee year, the entire Church is invited to look once again to St. Francis of Assisi, the Poverello, and to follow his shining example of holiness, humility, peace, simplicity, and love for all creation.



The Apostolic Penitentiary has granted a plenary indulgence, under the usual conditions, to all the faithful who participate devoutly in the jubilee celebrations.

As a parish proudly bearing the name of St. Francis of Assisi, this Jubilee holds special meaning for our parish. We are blessed to be a place of pilgrimage, where the faithful can encounter God's mercy, renew their faith, and grow in charity.

The grace of this Jubilee is open to everyone:

- Members of the Franciscan family and all religious inspired by Franciscan spirituality.

- All the faithful who, free from attachment to sin, make a pilgrimage to a Franciscan church or a church dedicated to St. Francis.
- The elderly, the sick, and those unable to travel, may share in the indulgence by spiritually uniting themselves to the Jubilee and offering their prayers and sufferings to God.



This Jubilee Year is a providential time of renewal and sanctification, calling us to transform our faith into concrete acts of love, mercy, and peace, and to become joyful witnesses of the Gospel in today's world.

This historic Roman Catholic community, was established 136 years ago through the collaboration between the Diocese of Sacramento and the Province of Our

In 2016, there was a pastoral transition from the Franciscan Friars to the Diocese of Sacramento. - Social Justice Ministries such as Pathways for Justice, and St. Vincent de Paul Conference to address community needs through outreach and advocacy.
- Parishioners are also very actively engaged in many other ministries such as St. Clare's Communion Visitation; pastoral and finance councils; and hospitality.

### VOCACIONES Y MAYORDOMÍA

Una vocación es un llamado. Para los católicos, significa el estado de vida que Dios nos pide vivir. Hay una vocación para cada persona bautizada: la santidad. La santidad es vivir constantemente en la presencia de Dios y tener una relación viva con Él. Esta relación se cultiva mediante la oración y los sacramentos. Todos estamos llamados también a una vocación particular en la vida, más allá de vivir una vida de santidad. Oremos para que cada uno de nosotros encuentre su vocación en la iglesia. Oremos también por más sacerdotes. Hay estampas de oración al final de las bancas que pueden compartir.

La oración por todas las vocaciones se recita cada **segundo domingo del mes.**

## UNDÉCIMO DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO (CICLO A): JESÚS ENVÍA A SUS DISCÍPULOS

El Evangelio comienza con una hermosa afirmación: "Al ver a la multitud, el corazón de Jesús se conmovió de compasión por ella, porque estaba afligida y abandonada, como ovejas sin pastor".

Si Dios me preguntara: "¿Qué virtud te gustaría recibir?", respondería sin vacilar: la compasión. Todo lo que Jesús hizo brotó de su corazón compasivo. Alimentó a los hambrientos, sanó a los enfermos, perdonó a los pecadores, acogió a los marginados y consoló a los que sufrían; todo ello, porque se sintió movido a compasión.

La palabra compasión proviene del Latín COM y PASSIO, que significa "sufrir con". No se trata simplemente de sentir lástima por alguien; es adentrarse en el dolor de otra persona y llevarlo con amor. Una persona compasiva no se apresura a juzgar ni a criticar. En cambio, se pregunta: "¿Qué le ha pasado a esta persona? ¿Por qué actúa así? ¿Qué carga lleva consigo?". La compasión transforma nuestra perspectiva. Dejamos de ver a las personas como problemas y empezamos a verlas como hermanos y hermanas amados por Dios. Un niño llevaba a su hermano menor a cuestras; el pequeño sufría una discapacidad y no podía caminar. Mientras el niño subía una colina empinada, un hombre que lo observaba sintió lástima y le preguntó: "Hijo, ¿no es esa una carga muy pesada para ti?".

El niño respondió de inmediato con una sonrisa: "¿Una carga? No, señor. Él no es una carga. Es mi hermano". El hombre se sintió profundamente conmovido. El peso sobre los hombros del niño no había cambiado, pero su perspectiva lo transformó todo. El amor convirtió la carga en un privilegio.

Cuando alguien nos pertenece, no lo condenamos apresuradamente; tratamos de comprenderlo. Así es como Jesús veía a las multitudes: miraba más allá de sus defectos y reconocía su profunda necesidad de amor, guía y sanación.

Entonces Jesús dice a sus discípulos: "La cosecha es abundante, pero los trabajadores son pocos. Pidan al dueño de la cosecha que envíe trabajadores a su mies". El requisito principal para un trabajador en la viña de Dios no es el talento, la educación ni el éxito, sino un corazón compasivo; un corazón que ve como ve Jesús y ama como ama Jesús.

### **Cristo otorga autoridad sobre el mal**

Jesús convoca a los doce apóstoles y les da autoridad sobre los espíritus impuros y sobre toda enfermedad y dolencia. Los nombres de los apóstoles se enumeran uno a uno, recordándonos que Cristo confía su misión y su poder a personas reales.

¿Qué significa esta autoridad sobre los espíritus impuros? Como católicos, creemos que el mal no es simplemente una idea o un símbolo; Satanás y los espíritus demoníacos son reales. El mismo Jesús se enfrentó a los demonios y los expulsó repetidamente durante su ministerio público. Si creemos en Jesús y en el Evangelio, no podemos ignorar sin más la realidad de los espíritus malignos. En el Padre Nuestro, Jesús nos enseñó a orar: "Líbranos del mal". No nos habría enseñado esta oración si el mal no fuera real.

Al mismo tiempo, no debemos obsesionarnos con los demonios ni imaginar que todos los problemas son causados por ellos. La Iglesia enseña que Cristo es infinitamente más poderoso que Satanás. El centro del Evangelio no es el poder del mal, sino la victoria de Cristo sobre el mal.

La batalla cotidiana contra el mal tiene lugar en nuestros corazones cada día. Siempre que cedemos al odio, los celos, el resentimiento, los chismes, el orgullo, el juicio o el egoísmo, permitimos que el espíritu del mal influya en nuestros pensamientos y acciones. Siempre que elegimos el perdón, la bondad, la humildad, la verdad y el amor, permitimos que el Espíritu Santo nos guíe. Por tanto, la pregunta no es si el mal existe, sino: ¿qué espíritu guía mi vida hoy? ¿Es el Espíritu de Cristo, que me conduce a la compasión, la misericordia y la santidad? ¿O estoy permitiendo que la negatividad, la ira y el egoísmo tomen el control?

La buena noticia del Evangelio de hoy es que Jesús ha dado a su Iglesia el poder de vencer al mal. A través de la oración, los sacramentos, la Palabra de Dios y una vida de fe, podemos vivir en la libertad de los hijos de Dios. Pidamos hoy al Señor: "Jesús, protégeme del mal y llénname de tu Espíritu Santo".

### **Empieza por el "Israel" que Dios te ha dado.**

En el Evangelio de hoy, Jesús dice a los apóstoles: "Id más bien a las ovejas perdidas de la casa de Israel". A primera vista, esto resulta sorprendente. ¿Por qué no enviarlos inmediatamente a todos? Más tarde, tras la Resurrección, Jesús sí les mandará ir a todas las naciones. Pero primero, los envía a su propio pueblo.

Aquí hay una enseñanza para nosotros. En toda vida hay un ámbito conocido y otro desconocido. Antes de intentar cambiar el mundo entero, Dios nos pide que comencemos por las personas más cercanas a nosotros: nuestra familia, nuestros parientes, nuestros vecinos, nuestro lugar de trabajo, nuestra parroquia. Ese es nuestro "Israel".

A veces tenemos afán por corregir a desconocidos mientras descuidamos a aquellos que Dios ya ha confiado a nuestro cuidado. Jesús dice: empieza donde estás. Sé testigo de fe, bondad, perdón y caridad primero en tu propio círculo.

Hay otra enseñanza. Jesús les dice que no entren en territorio samaritano en esta etapa. Espiritualmente, esto nos recuerda que no debemos precipitarnos a juzgar situaciones que no comprendemos. Muchas veces criticamos a las personas sin conocer sus luchas, heridas o circunstancias. Entramos en territorios que desconocemos.

Antes de juzgar a los demás, debemos aprender humildad. Solo Dios ve el panorama completo. En lugar de críticas, ofrezcamos comprensión; en lugar de condena, ofrezcamos oración.

Cuando los apóstoles fueron fieles a su misión en Israel, Jesús más tarde les confió el mundo entero. Lo mismo ocurre con nosotros. Si somos fieles en el pequeño círculo que Dios nos ha dado hoy, Él abrirá puertas más grandes mañana.

Así que preguntémonos: ¿Quiénes son las "ovejas perdidas" en mi propio Israel —mi familia, mi comunidad, mi lugar de trabajo—? Quizás Jesús me esté enviando a ellas primero. Antes de llegar a los confines de la tierra, permíteme comenzar con las personas que Dios ya ha puesto en mi vida. Que el Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, rebosante de misericordia y compasión, transforme nuestros corazones. Que aprendamos a ver a cada persona como Jesús la ve y nos convirtamos en instrumentos de su amor en el mundo.
