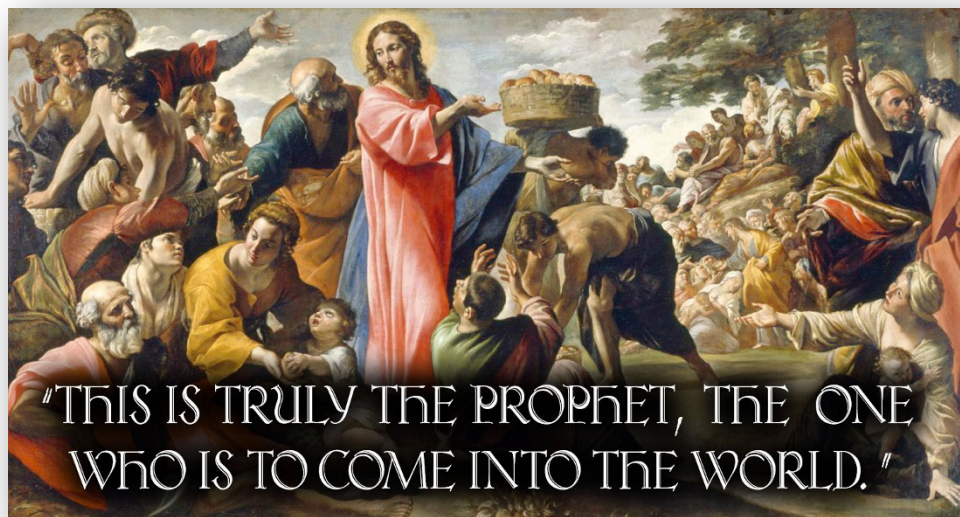

FIRST READING | 2 Kgs 4:42-44

A man came from Baal-shalishah bringing to Elisha, the man of God, twenty barley loaves made from the firstfruits, and fresh grain in the ear. Elisha said, "Give it to the people to eat." But his servant objected, "How can I set this before a hundred people?" Elisha insisted, "Give it to the people to eat." "For thus says the LORD, 'They shall eat and there shall be some left over.'" And when they had eaten, there was some left over, as the LORD had said.

GOSPEL | Jn 6:1-15

Jesus went across the Sea of Galilee. A large crowd followed him, because they saw the signs he was performing on the sick. Jesus went up on the mountain, and there he sat down with his disciples. The Jewish feast of Passover was near. When Jesus raised his eyes and saw that a large crowd was coming to him, he said to Philip, "Where can we buy enough food for them to eat?" He said this to test him, because he himself knew what he was going to do. Philip answered him, "Two hundred days' wages worth of food would not be enough for each of them to have a little." One of his disciples, Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, said to him, "There is a boy here who has five barley loaves and two fish; but what good are these for so many?" Jesus said, "Have the people recline." Now there was a great deal of grass in that place. So the men reclined, about five thousand in number. Then Jesus took the loaves, gave thanks, and distributed them to those who were reclining, and also as much of the fish as they wanted. When they had had their fill, he said to his disciples, "Gather the fragments left over, so that nothing will be wasted." So they collected them, and filled twelve wicker baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves that had been more than they could eat. When the people saw the sign he had done, they said, "This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world." Since Jesus knew that they were going to come and carry him off to make him king, he withdrew again to the mountain alone.

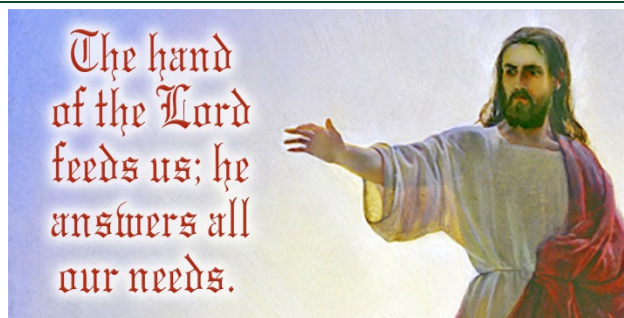

REFLECTIONS

“FACE-TIME”

“The Lord used to speak to Moses face-to-face.” —Exodus 33:11

What an indescribable picture! Almighty God and a human being speak face-to-face and Moses does not die (cf Ex 24:11; 33:20; Is 6:5). Even more amazing is that God has invited each person to have that kind of access to Himself (Eph 2:18). Each of us can also have a face-to-face encounter with the Lord, particularly in Eucharistic Adoration. In addition, at each Mass, we can gaze on the consecrated host, the Body and Blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ, the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity.

God speaks to us in the Sacred Scriptures. St. Jerome stated: “Ignorance of the Scriptures is ignorance of Christ” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 133). A great way to converse with the Lord and hear what He is saying is to daily read the Word of God. In the Sacrament of Reconciliation, Jesus Himself, through the priest, forgives and absolves our sins.

Jesus is present to us in our Christian brothers and sisters. “Where two or three are gathered in My name, there am I in their midst” (Mt 18:20). Jesus is Emmanuel, God-with-us (Mt 1:23; 28:20). He has given us numerous ways to see and hear Him. Go to Mass as often as possible, even daily. Read the Word of God daily and receive the Sacraments frequently. “Gaze on the loveliness of the Lord” (Ps 27:4).

Prayer: Father, You do not hold Yourself aloof from us. May I turn ten times the more to seek You, beginning today (Bar 4:28).

Promise: “As far as the east is from the west, so far has He put our transgressions from us.” —Ps 103:12

Praise: Victoria has spent many blessed hours in adoration before the Blessed Sacrament.

MULTIPLICATION TABLE

“How can I set this before a hundred men?” —2 Kings 4:43

Many times, what we have to offer seems so inadequate. We may only have a couple free hours a week. So how can we renew the Church? We may be confined to home. Our main contact with people is by phone. Under these circumstances, how can we make disciples of all nations? (Mt 28:19) We have five dollars to give, but the church needs \$100,000 to shelter the homeless. What good is five dollars?

We often find ourselves in the same situation as Jesus when He found Himself with five loaves, two fish, and fifteen to twenty thousand people to feed (Jn 6:9). Perhaps we don't need food multiplied as much as time, energy, and money multiplied. We need Jesus' multiplication miracle daily to change our inadequacy into His sufficiency. Jesus works this miracle daily in the Mass. Because of this, the early Church called the Mass “breaking of the bread” (see Acts 2:42). When Jesus breaks bread, our little lives are multiplied to transform the world.

Prayer: Jesus, I give You all of my little life. Multiply it.

Promise: “Make every effort to preserve the unity which has the Spirit as its origin and peace as its binding force.” —Eph 4:3

Praise: “Indeed, God calls even the body to resurrection, and promises it everlasting life” (St. Justin Martyr, Second Century). Praise You, risen Jesus, for inspiring our greatest saints!

REFLECTIONS

“IT’S GOD’S FAULT”

“Lord, are You not concerned that my sister has left me to do the household tasks all alone? Tell her to help me.” —Luke 10:40

St. Martha blamed Jesus, that is, God, for not telling Mary to help her. We also blame God for not stopping tragedies and for not doing what we want. Martha seemed close to blaming God again for not preventing the death of her brother Lazarus (Jn 11:21). However, she refrained from blaming God, started believing God (Jn 11:27), and saw the glory of God as her brother was raised from the dead and unbound by Jesus (Jn 11:44). When your output exceeds your input, then your upkeep becomes your downfall. In other words, when we try to do more than we have received the grace from God to do, the living of our everyday lives will cause us to break down. Moreover, when we are blaming God, we set up an obstacle which prevents us from freely receiving His grace, His input into our lives. (We don’t receive much from people that we blame.) Therefore, we must repent of blaming God, or we will fall apart.

Don’t blame God. He alone is innocent. Thank and love God. He alone is worthy. Receive His grace. See His glory.

Prayer: Father, I will take the plank out of my eye and not criticize You (Mt 7:5).

Promise: “I had rather one day in Your courts than a thousand elsewhere.” —Ps 84:11

Praise: Like many of us, St. Martha often let the cares of the world obscure her vision. But in the end, she was graced with the most significant of titles — Saint.

Todos, pues, se sentaron ahí; y tan sólo los hombres eran unos cinco mil. Enseguida tomó Jesús los panes, y después de dar gracias a Dios, se los fue repartiendo a los que se habían sentado a comer. Igualmente les fue dando de los pescados todo lo que quisieron. Después de que todos se saciaron, dijo a sus discípulos: “Recojan los pedazos sobrantes, para que no se desperdicien”. Los recogieron y con los pedazos que sobraron de los cinco panes llenaron doce canastos. Entonces la gente, al ver el signo que Jesús había hecho, decía: “Éste es, en verdad, el profeta que habría de venir al mundo”. Pero Jesús, sabiendo que iban a llevárselo para proclamarlo rey, se retiró de nuevo a la montaña, él solo.

“¿Cómo voy a servir esto a cien personas?” (2 Reyes 4:43)
2 Reyes 4:42-44; Salmos 145:10-11, 15-18; Efesios 4:1-6; Juan 6:1-15

Muchas veces, lo que tenemos para ofrecer parece tan inadecuado. Puede que solo pudiéramos dedicar un par de horas libres a la semana. Entonces, ¿cómo podremos renovar la Iglesia? Aún peor, podemos estar confinados en casa. El teléfono se convierte en nuestro principal contacto con la gente. En estas circunstancias, ¿cómo poder hacer discípulos de todas las naciones? (Mt 28:19). Tenemos solo cinco dólares para ofrendar, pero la Iglesia necesita \$100,000 para alojar a las personas sin hogar. ¿Para qué sirven esos cinco dólares?

A menudo nos encontramos en la misma situación que Jesús cuando se encontró solo con cinco panes y dos peces para alimentar a una multitud de entre quince y veinte mil personas (Jn 6:9). Quizás no necesitamos multiplicar los alimentos tanto como el tiempo, la energía y el dinero. Necesitamos el milagro de multiplicación de Jesús todos los días para cambiar nuestra insuficiencia en Su Suficiencia. Jesús hace este milagro diariamente en la Misa. De hecho, la Iglesia primitiva llamó a la Misa "fracción del pan" (ver Hch 2:42). Cuando Jesús parte el pan, nuestras pequeñas vidas son multiplicadas para transformar el mundo.
