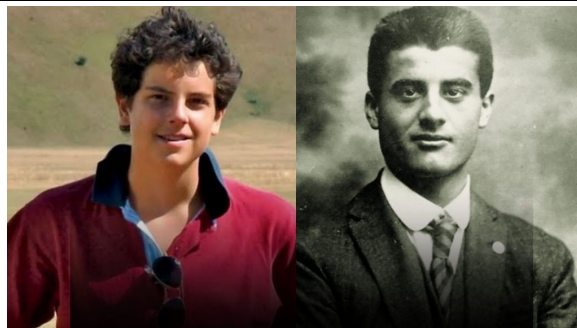

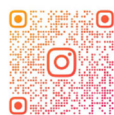

TWENTY-THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME | FREE TO LOVE

St. Paul must have understood today's Gospel very well. Like Jesus, he knew what being a disciple would cost. It landed him in prison. Yet he seems to have no regrets; he accepts that imprisonment as part of his discipleship. Also like Jesus, he is not afraid to ask others to take that discipleship seriously. And he is not ashamed to ask a favor: Would Philemon accept his runaway slave, Onesimus, back into his home? Not just as a slave, but as a member of his family. He shamelessly calls himself a prisoner for Christ five times in the short letter (three times in our reading). If that didn't tug Philemon's heart-strings, Paul also calls himself an old man.

In the Gospel, Jesus talks about the cost of discipleship. Paul takes that a step further; he reminds us to accept that cost freely. He could have ordered his friend to free the slave. Paul was an apostle, a leader in the early church. Instead of giving an order, he called on Philemon to respond freely to his request. Perhaps we can learn from that example.

Like Paul, when Jesus commands us to love one another, he leaves us free to accept that challenge. Remember, he always says, "Love one another, as I have loved you" (John 13:34). Jesus was never compelled to cure anyone or forgive their sins. No one ordered him to feed the hungry with loaves and fishes or raise Lazarus from the dead. Yet how often do we go to church because we were told we have to? Do we volunteer for the picnic only because the pastor twists our arm? Or do we love Jesus so much that we volunteer to help without being asked? Do we love Jesus enough to invite others to follow him?

We can live life just doing what we have to. Or when Jesus offers us a new motive—love for God because God loves us—we can choose to follow him freely. In John's Gospel, there is no Agony in the Garden. He shows us that Jesus chose to obey his Father and willingly took up the cross. Let us ask the Spirit to fill us with the freedom to love.

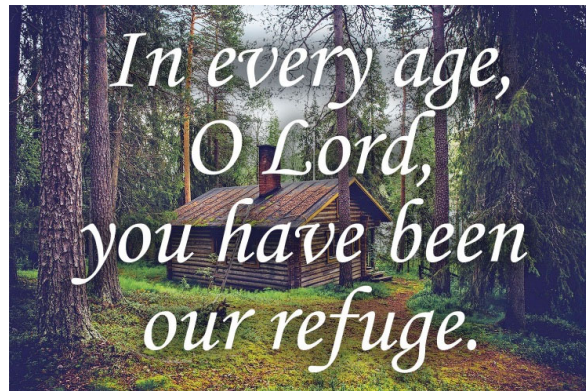

Special Ministry:

Fr. Franz was confessor of 2 Bishops with another bishop and a Cardinal coming occasionally for confession.

Highlights of his ministry:

a.) A Diocesan turned Religious / A hesitant Founder:

Ordained a diocesan, Fr. Franz aspired to a life of contemplation. After his asylum and before he took over the position as Diocesan Director for the yearlong 1985 celebration of the Philippine National Marian Year, he was granted his Bishop's permission to enter monastic life. But this didn't get thru because the same bishop commissioned him to found instead religious congregations now known as Sons of Mary Adorers of the Holy Eucharist (SMAHE) (for priests and brothers) and Sisters of Mary Adorers of the Holy Eucharist. (SMAHE). These congregations were inspired in the ate-room of the office of His Holiness (now Saint) John Paul II while waiting for his turn (together with the Philippine Bishops) for private audience during the Ad Lima Visit during the time he was his bishop's private secretary.



Engrossed for quiet life and considering the permission for contemplative life that was already granted, Fr. Franz hesitated to found. However, since priestly vow of obedience for him is a must, he gave up the "desire for quiet life" and founded SMAHE in obedience to his bishop. Hence the Sons and Sisters of Mary Adorers of the Holy Eucharist.

b.) A privilege:

1. He was offered to become a bishop by the Cardinal who comes occasionally for confession. However, grateful, he modestly declined to become a bishop in exchange for missionary work and remained an ordinary priest. His Eminence Ricardo J. Cardinal Vidal became Fr. Franz's spiritual father and guide.
2. He received an invitation for a position at the Our Lady of Lourdes in France but humbly declined to avoid complication with his religious duties with congregations that was yet very young.
3. He served twice as his bishop's private secretary to the *Ad Limina Visit* in 1985, where the inspiration to found SMAHE took place, and in 1998, respectively.

A lifetime Ministry:

In connection with SMAHE, Fr. Franz founded and is currently operating mission schools scattered in the Philippine mission areas including a college seminary and orphanages with extension in Vietnam.



SMAHE is the acronym of a semi-contemplative twin religious congregation for priests and brothers or nuns: the Sons and Sisters of Mary Adorers of the Holy Eucharist. SMAHE was inspired by the Holy Spirit when a 36 year old Filipino priest, Rev. Franz M. Crucis had his first audience with the Saint John Paul II in October 1985 at His Holiness' office inside the Vatican in Rome. In 1986, guided by the Blessed Virgin Mary coupled with the permission and blessing by Bishop Celso Guevarra, the Sisters congregation was founded; followed quickly (in 1988) by the congregation for the Priests

and Brothers

Although third world countries are known to be very poor countries, not everyone is actually poor. In the Philippines, there is a handful of rich but, boy, poverty is everywhere. In a particular scenario like this, the gap between the rich and the poor is so wide, it's like heaven and earth; the rich continue to get richer and the poor becomes poorer.



Up on the streets of the metropolitan Manila and down in the provinces, unwanted children, neglected, abused, scavengers, homeless and orphaned, including child labor, are a common sight. Pictures such as these make emotions run high. It is almost impossible for a person to hold his/her emotions whenever he/she sees these little angels asleep along the streets, laying sick or abandoned without anybody's care, and/or searching for food in the trash, knowing that they will grow up without a proper education.

With a very bad economy prevailing in the country (where an ordinary laborer gets only \$3 a day), the Philippine government is helpless in responding to this perennial problem without the help of Non Government Organizations or Religious Organizations, like SMAHE, that run Charitable Institutions.

Concerned of the welfare of these unfortunate children, whose God's *"kingdom they belong"* (Mt. 19:14), Fr. Crucis founded the Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe (OVG), where the *"children be fed first"* (Mk 7:27). The toddlers and female teenagers are under the care of Nuns while teenage boys are under the care of Brothers. There they learn and experience what love really means.



For ten years, the kids were housed in a house that was lent free of charge by an old lady. But when she passed away, the heir kicked the kids out. Leaving in haste, these little angels relocated with their guardian-nuns and lived like cramped sardines in a one-bedroom rented house.

By the grace of God and with the help of some friends, three modest houses now stand in a 3-acre property that was donated for this purpose. These houses, which were built according to God's Word, are a place of love, trust, mutual interest and unselfish service, i.e. a place of harmony and contentment. These houses *have* become a home.

While OVG was originally intended only as home for less fortunate children, it has recently become also a shelter for runaways, rape victims, and incest victims. The care for these less fortunate little angels is a duty and responsibility of every baptized Christian for *"whatever you do to the least of your brothers you do it to me"* (Mt. 25:40).

It is for this reason that in 1998 the late Pope John Paul II, at Abujan Nigeria, echoed the same sentiment when he said, “*We must all work for a world in which no child will be deprived of peace and security, of a stable family life, of the right to grow up without fear and anxiety.*”

Children need food and money for medicine and education. Moreover, the construction of a Medical and Dental facility which was started 4 years ago, is on hold due to lack of money and needs approximately \$10,000 for its completion.



SMAHE needs financial support to sustain the priestly education of its 63 seminarians. Many have come to OVG as orphans and have grown up dedicating their lives to God, but have no monetary means to achieve their goals in life. Monthly food and lodging *alone* currently stand at \$100 per seminarian.

In 2001, the Foundation for The Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe (FOVG) was founded by Mike DeMinter and his wife, Amie, as a tax exempt avenue for those who wished to support SMAHE and OVG. Mike and Amie, on three occasions, visited the orphanage located at Lavezares, Northern Samar, Philippines and saw for themselves the needs and witnessed the operations of OVG and SMAHE. To better assist in providing the needs of OVG and SMAHE, FOVG has placed itself under the directorship of Fr. Crucis. FOVG is 501(c)(3) Tax Exempt No. 91-2142480.

Orphanage Graduates, Both Successful And Unsuccessful

Genalyn B.

Genalyn was a 2-months old when put up for sale for \$47.00 by her family, due to poverty. When the Orphanage of the Virgin of Guadalupe (OVG) Director, learned of this, he counseled the family against it and tried, unsuccessfully, to find both parents jobs. But the need was urgent. Therefore, the Director paid the amount and brought the baby to the orphanage.

Lynlyn, as she was fondly called, grew up to be a beautiful twenty old woman and was in her 3rd year of Pharmacy at St. Jude's College when, unfortunately, she left school and all access to her has been lost.

Kevin D.

Kevin was born out of wedlock. Unwanted by the family, a couple tried to adopt him but the couple's children disapproved the idea. Thus, he ended up at the orphanage. Kevin left after completing 2 years of college, went to work on the outside, and is doing well.

Geru L.

Geru was one year and 6 months old, badly malnourished and sick when the OVG Director, saw him in the dirty arms of his malnourished mother. His mother, having been raped and traumatized, was sick and on the verge of losing her mind. Jobless, she would search for anything to eat by the seashore (where Geru's older and only sister had drowned while scavenging for food).

It was so touching when the mother handed over her son to the OVG Director. The mother never stopped crying, but she had to give her son up for a better future. She passed away a year later. After completing 2 years of college, Geru decided to go out on his own. He is doing well.

Bryan H.

Brian is the youngest of 8 children. His father became mentally incapacitated, was confined to a mental hospital and, eventually, died there.

With his father confined to a hospital, the already poor living condition of the family worsened. Bryan's mother, who could hardly raise enough money for the family's basic needs, had to sell all that they had, including their belongings, for her husband's medication and the subsistence of their 8 children. Finally Brian, then 8 months old, had to be given up; the reason why he ended up in the orphanage.

VIGÉSIMO TERCER DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO | LIBRES PARA AMAR

San Pablo debió comprender muy bien el Evangelio de hoy. Al igual que Jesús, sabía lo que costaría ser discípulo. Hasta lo llevó a la cárcel. Sin embargo, parece no estar arrepentido; acepta ese encarcelamiento como parte de su discipulado. También, como Jesús, no tiene miedo de pedir a otros que tomen en serio ese discipulado. Y no le da vergüenza pedir un favor: ¿Aceptaría Filemón a su esclavo fugitivo, Onésimo, de vuelta en su casa? No solo como esclavo, sino como miembro de su familia. No le da vergüenza llamarse prisionero de Cristo cinco veces en esta breve carta (tres veces en la lectura de hoy). Si eso no conmueve a Filemón, Pablo también se llama anciano.

En el Evangelio, Jesús habla del precio del discipulado. Pablo va un paso más allá; nos recuerda que debemos aceptar ese precio libremente. Podría haberle ordenado a su amigo que liberara al esclavo. Pablo era un apóstol, un líder en la Iglesia primitiva. En lugar de darle una orden, le pidió a Filemón que respondiera libremente a su petición. Quizás podamos aprender de ese ejemplo.

Al igual que Pablo, cuando Jesús nos manda amarnos unos a otros, nos da la libertad de aceptar ese reto. Recuerden, siempre dice: “Ámense unos a los otros, como yo los he amado” (Juan 13,34). Jesús nunca se vio obligado a curar a nadie ni a perdonar sus pecados. Nadie le ordenó alimentar a los hambrientos con panes y peces ni resucitar a Lázaro. Lo hizo por amor. Sin embargo, ¿con qué frecuencia vamos a la iglesia porque nos dicen que tenemos que ir? ¿Nos ofrecemos ser voluntarios para el picnic solo porque el párroco nos suplica? ¿O amamos tanto a Jesús que nos ofrecemos a ayudar sin que nos lo pidan? ¿Amamos a Jesús lo suficiente como para invitar a otros a seguirlo?

Podemos vivir la vida simplemente haciendo lo que tenemos que hacer. O cuando Jesús nos ofrece una nueva motivación — amar a Dios porque Dios nos ama — podemos elegir seguirlo libremente. Durante su Pasión, Jesús nos mostró que eligió obedecer a su Padre y tomó voluntariamente la cruz. Pidamos al Espíritu Santo que nos llene de la libertad de amar.
