## REFLECTIONS

### ENTER THE HOUSE OF LOVE

When we enter into the household of God, we come to realize that the fragmentation of humanity and its agony grow from the false supposition that all human beings have to fight for their right to be appreciated and loved. In the house of God's love we come to see with new eyes and hear with new ears and thus recognize all people, whatever their race, religion, sex, wealth, intelligence, or background, belong to that same house. God's house has no dividing walls or closed doors. "I am the door," Jesus says. "Anyone who enters through me will be safe" (John 10:9). The more fully we enter into the house of love, the more clearly we see that we are there together with all humanity and that in and through Christ we are brothers and sisters, members of one family.

**LOVING THOSE WHO HURT YOU | "Take no revenge and cherish no grudge against your fellow countrymen.**

**You shall love your neighbor as yourself. I am the Lord." —Leviticus 19:18**

Jesus was asked: "Teacher, which commandment of the law is the greatest?" (Mt 22:36) Jesus surprised His questioner by mentioning not one commandment but two. He surprised all of Judaism by maintaining that loving one's neighbor as oneself is the second commandment, and together with the first commandment forms the basis of the law and the prophets (Mt 22:40; cf Rm 13:10).

The Biblical context for the second commandment isn't merely about generally helping out our neighbors or being friendly to them. In Leviticus 19:18, to love our neighbor specifically means not bearing hatred toward them, not taking revenge on them, and not cherishing a grudge against them. So, when Jesus was asked to name the greatest commandment, He did not merely add to the first commandment the command to love our neighbor; He also implied a prohibition against hating, taking revenge, and cherishing grudges.

Is there anyone you hate? Do you want to get revenge on someone? Are you holding a grudge? Have you forgiven from your heart everyone for everything? (Mt 18:35) Do you love your neighbor as yourself by God's standards? This Lent, be reconciled, forgive, and love your neighbor.

**Prayer:** Sacred Heart of Jesus, purify my heart this Lent to love the Samaritans and enemies in my life (Lk 10:29ff).

**Promise:** "Are you not aware that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?" —1 Cor 3:16

**Praise:** Praise the risen Jesus, Who is the cause of our joy!

### IT'S YOUR CHOICE

**"I have set before you life and death, the blessing and the curse. Choose life." —Deuteronomy 30:19**

Recently, a group of Catholics were praying a rosary in front of the local abortion mill. A car drove by and a woman shouted at the group, "My body, my choice!" She made a choice as proclaimed in today's Mass readings: to choose life or death, blessing or curse (Dt 30:19).

How incredible that Almighty God gives us human beings the freedom to choose our own eternal destiny, heaven or hell. There is no other option. The love of God is so magnanimous and total that He offers us freedom to make such powerful choices (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 160). However, in that same love, He reveals Himself so that we might have every opportunity to choose both Him and His love. God desires to overwhelm us with blessings (Dt 28:2). Yet we have to choose the life of blessings He sets before us (Dt 30:19).

At the conclusion of Lent, at the Easter Vigil or on Easter Sunday, we will renew our baptismal promises. The priest will ask us six questions only answered "Yes" or "No." Likewise, only two choices are offered by God: heaven or hell, life or death, the kingdom of God or the kingdom of darkness.

As we begin Lent, "choose life" (Dt 30:19). Choose blessing. Reject the curse. Reject hell. Choose God.

**Prayer:** Father, this Lent, may I choose Your way of life every moment of every day.

**Promise:** "Whoever wishes to be My follower must deny his very self, take up his cross each day, and follow in My steps. Whoever would save his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for My sake will save it." —Lk 9:23-24

**Praise:** "Eighty-six years I have served Him, and He has never done me wrong. How, then, should I be able to blaspheme my King Who has saved me?" (The Martyrdom of Polycarp, 155 AD)

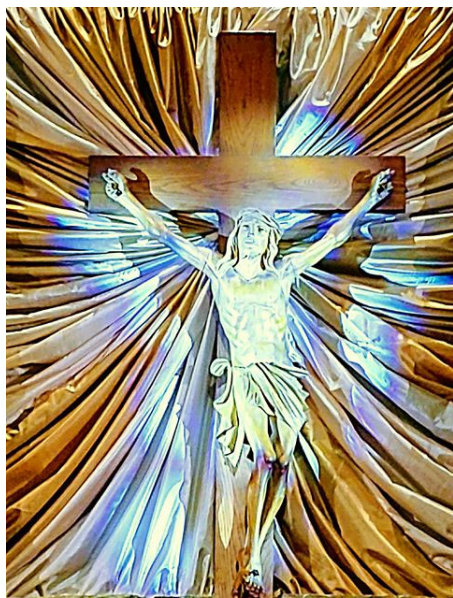

## REFLEXIONES

### ES TU ELECCIÓN

**"He puesto delante de ti la vida y la muerte, la bendición y la maldición. Elige la vida" (Deuteronomio 30:19).**

Recientemente, un grupo de católicos estaba rezando un rosario frente a una clínica de abortos local. Pasó un automóvil y una mujer gritó al grupo: "¡Mi cuerpo, mi elección!" Ella tomó una decisión como se proclama en las lecturas de la Misa de hoy: elegir la vida o la muerte, la bendición o la maldición (Dt 30:19).

Qué increíble que Dios Todopoderoso nos dé a los seres humanos la libertad de elegir nuestro destino eterno, el cielo o el infierno. No hay otra opción. El amor de Dios es tan magnánimo y total que Él nos ofrece la libertad de tomar decisiones tan poderosas (Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, 160). Sin embargo, en ese mismo amor, Él se revela a Sí mismo para que podamos tener todas las oportunidades de elegirlo tanto a Él como a Su amor. Dios desea abrumarnos con bendiciones (Dt 28:2). Sin embargo, tenemos que elegir la vida de bendiciones que Él pone ante nosotros (Dt 30:19).

Al final de la Cuaresma, en la Vigilia Pascual o en Domingo de Pascua, renovaremos nuestras promesas bautismales. El sacerdote nos hará seis preguntas que solo se responden con "Sí" o "No". Del mismo modo, Dios solo ofrece dos opciones: el cielo o el infierno, la vida o la muerte, el reino de Dios o el reino de las tinieblas.

Al comenzar la Cuaresma, "escoge la vida" (Dt 30:19). Elige la bendición. Rechaza la maldición. Rechaza el infierno. Elige a Dios. Oración: Padre, que en esta Cuaresma, pueda elegir Tu forma de vida en cada momento del día.

**Promesa:** "El que quiera venir detrás de Mí, que renuncie a sí mismo, que cargue con su cruz cada día y Me siga. Porque el que quiera salvar su vida, la perderá y el que pierda su vida por Mí, la salvará" (Lc 9:23-24).

**Alabanza:** "Ochenta y seis años le he servido, y Él nunca me ha hecho daño. ¿Cómo, entonces, seré capaz de blasfemar contra mi Rey que me ha salvado?" (El martirio de Policarpo, 155 d.C.)

**AMANDO A LOS QUE TE LASTIMARON | "No serás vengativo con tus compatriotas ni les guardarás rencor.**

**Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo. Yo soy el Señor" (Levítico 19:18).**

Le preguntaron a Jesús: "Maestro, ¿cuál es el mandamiento más grande de la Ley?". Jesús sorprendió a su interlocutor al mencionar no un mandamiento sino dos. Sorprendió a todo el judaísmo al sostener que amar al prójimo como a uno mismo es el segundo mandamiento, y junto con el primero forma la base de la ley y los profetas (Mt 22:40; ver Rom 13:10).

El contexto bíblico para el segundo mandamiento no se trata simplemente de ayudar a nuestros vecinos en general o ser amigable con ellos. En Levítico 19:18, amar a nuestro prójimo significa específicamente no tener odio hacia él, no vengarse de él y no guardarle rencor. Entonces, cuando se le pidió a Jesús que nombrara el mandamiento más importante, Él no se limitó a agregar al primer mandamiento el mandato de amar a nuestro prójimo; también insinuó una prohibición contra el odio, la venganza y el abrigar rencores.

¿Hay alguien a quien odias? ¿Quieres vengarte de alguien? ¿Estás guardando un rencor? ¿Has perdonado de corazón a todos por todo? (Mt 18:35). ¿Amas a tu prójimo como a ti mismo según las normas de Dios? En esta Cuaresma reconcílate, perdona y ama a tu prójimo.

**Oración:** Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, purifica mi corazón esta Cuaresma para amar a los samaritanos y enemigos en mi vida (Lc 10:29ss).

**Promesa:** "¿No saben que ustedes son templo de Dios y que el Espíritu de Dios habita en ustedes?" (1 Co 3:16)

**Alabanza:** ¡Alabado sea Jesús resucitado, que es la causa de nuestro gozo!

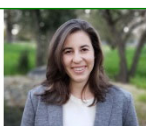
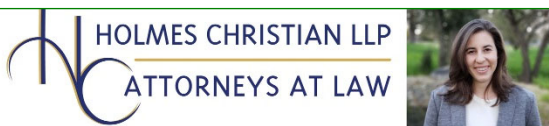
