RECONCILIATION — True reconciliation is emotional, dramatic, and cleansing. When two people meet heart to heart and work through old hurts, misunderstandings, and careless words, cleansing tears often flow and the encounter ends with an embrace that fills both with the warmth of a love too strong to fade.

The readings this weekend assure us of this healthy release that comes with reconciliation. They give us the courage to reach out to someone with whom we need to reconcile ourselves, and give us the courage to ask for forgiveness from God, too.

In the reading from Exodus, we see how God refuses again and again to give up on the Israelites. Even though they grow impatient with God and turn to false idols, God still calls them back. Luke's Gospel assures us that God rejoices when we turn away from sin. Paul's letter to Timothy encourages us, like Paul, to look back on our lives and recognize where God's patient mercy has been shown to us. . Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.

JUBILEE YEAR OF MERCY | SEPTEMBER 11, 2016 | TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME



When religious people complained that Jesus welcomed and ate with sinners, Jesus challenged them to change their image of God. Imagine God as a shepherd, abandoning ninety-nine obedient sheep to seek the stupid one who got lost. Imagine God as a distraught woman (could religious men imagine that?), losing something and turning the house upside down to find it. Imagine God as an unconditionally forgiving father granting an unworthy son an undeserved feast. Then Jesus added a character whom religious people might imagine, even recognize, all too well. The elder son stayed home; obeyed the father's will; then exploded with rage and judgment and refused to join his brother's welcome-home feast. This *Jubilee Year of Mercy* asks, which half of Jesus' audience do I belong to? How do I imagine God? How can I become like the searching shepherd, the sweeping woman, the forgiving father? How else can I expect a welcome to Jesus' feast of forgiveness?

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QUESTIONS OF THE WEEK | TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Theme: Come home. God's forgiveness is always there. God forgives before we even ask for forgiveness.

Breaking Open the Word: Suggested text for faith sharing: Today's Gospel, just the story of the Prodigal Son

Step One: Listen to the Word: You have heard this parable many times. When you listened to it today, what word or phrase or image really struck you? What feeling does this story leave you with?

Step Two: Look into Your Life: QUESTION FOR CHILDREN: The father in this story welcomed his son home, even after he ran away and did bad things. How do you know God welcomes you after you do that? QUESTION FOR YOUTH: The prodigal son was welcomed home even though he had sinned. How hard is it for you to ask for forgiveness? Is it hard for you to believe that you are still loved even when you have sinned? QUESTION FOR ADULTS: When you wander away from being true to your faith, how do you know God will take you back? What signs do you see?

LONGING TO BELONG

"Why, O Lord, should Your wrath blaze up against Your own people?" —Exodus 32:11

After the Israelites sinned by adoring the golden calf, the Lord gave Moses the impression that the people belonged to Moses, not Him (Ex 32:7). Moses implored the Lord and referred to the people as belonging to the Lord (Ex 32:11).

The prodigal son felt that he no longer belonged in his father's family after what he had done (Lk 15:18, 21). His older brother agreed with him (see Lk 15:30). However, the prodigal son's father would hear none of this. He spoke of the prodigal son as "this son of mine" (Lk 15:24).

"Once you were no people, but now you are God's people" (1 Pt 2:10). We belong to God (Rm 14:8). We are a people peculiarly His own (Dt 26:18). He created and redeemed us. "You are not your own. You have been purchased, and at a price" (1 Cor 6:19-20). We are doubly owned by God.

Acknowledge that you belong to God. Rejoice to be owned by the all-powerful Creator and the all-loving Redeemer. Every day, pray and say with Paul: "I have been crucified with Christ, and the life I live now is not my own; Christ is living in me" (Gal 2:19-20). You belong to Him alone.

Prayer: Father, may I know to Whom I belong and therefore where I belong.

Promise: "But we had to celebrate and rejoice! This brother of yours was dead, and has come back to life. He was lost, and is found." —Lk 15:32

Praise: Praise Jesus, who died so that we may live. Glory, honor, and might be to our God forever!

Las lecturas esta semana nos aseguran que una saludable liberación acompaña la reconciliación. Ellas nos dan el valor de acercarnos a alguien con quien necesitemos reconciliarnos, y también nos dan valor para pedir perdón a Dios.

En la lectura del Éxodo, vemos cómo Dios se niega una y otra vez a abandonar a los israelitas. Aunque ellos se impacientan con Dios y adoran falsos dioses, Dios todavía vuelve a llamarlos. El Evangelio de san Lucas nos asegura que Dios se regocija cuando nos apartamos del pecado. REQUISITOS PARA LAS QUINCEAÑERAS

1. La joven quinceañera necesita haber recibido sus Sacramentos de Iniciación Cristiana: Bautismo, Confirmación, y Comunión.
2. Participación en la Misa los domingos.
3. Reservar la iglesia por lo menos 6 meses antes de la celebración.
4. Deben llenar una forma con su información personal y recibir un folleto con las lecturas y más información. La forma y el folleto están disponibles en la oficina.
5. La quinceañera y sus acompañantes deben participar en 3 reuniones de preparación espiritual al evento religioso. El Sacerdote les avisará del día y la hora.
6. La celebración en la Iglesia es por naturaleza un evento espiritual, por lo tanto se espera que los acompañantes junto con la quinceañera se preparen para este evento. Se ofrecerá el Sacramento de la Confesión si así lo desean.
7. Es costumbre programar una hora y día para el ensayo en la Iglesia. La quinceañera junto con sus acompañantes deben participar.
8. Se exige puntualidad para la celebración.
9. La quinceañera y sus acompañantes deben vestirse con modestia.

ANHELO DE PERTENECER

"¿Por qué, Señor, arderá tu ira contra tu pueblo?" (Éxodo 32, 11).

Después de que los israelitas pecaron adorando al becerro de oro, el Señor le dio a Moisés la impresión de que las personas pertenecían a Moisés, no a Él (Ex 32, 7). Moisés imploró al Señor y se refirió a las personas como pertenecientes al Señor (Ex 32,11).

El hijo pródigo sentía que ya no pertenecía a la familia de su padre después de lo que había hecho (Lc 15,18,21). Su hermano mayor estaba de acuerdo con él (ver Lc 15, 30). Sin embargo, el padre del hijo pródigo no estuvo de acuerdo. Habló del hijo pródigo como "mi hijo" (Lc 15, 24).

"Ustedes, que antes no eran un pueblo, ahora son el Pueblo de Dios" (1 Pe 2, 10). Pertenecemos a Dios (Romanos 14, 8). Somos un pueblo peculiarmente Suyo (Dt 26, 18). Él nos creó y redimió. "Ustedes no se pertenecen, sino que han sido comprados, ¡y a qué precio!" (1 Co 6, 19-20) Pertenecemos doblemente a Dios. Reconoce que perteneces a Dios. Alégrate de ser propiedad del Creador todopoderoso y Redentor amoroso. Cada día, ora y di con Pablo: "Yo estoy crucificado con Cristo, y ya no vivo yo, sino que Cristo vive en mí" (Gal 2,19-20). Le perteneces solo a Él.

Oración: Padre, que pueda saber a Quién le pertenezco y por lo tanto adonde pertenezco.
