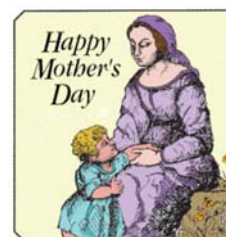

#### THE TEMPTATION TO DO GOOD

**"This will permit us to concentrate on prayer and the ministry of the word." —Acts 6:4**

There is no chaining the Word of God (2 Tm 2:9), but the messengers of God's Word can be chained. We are often chained through sin, selfishness, or fear. However, we can be chained in more subtle ways. For example, the devil tried to chain the apostles by making them think they needed to cut back temporarily on prayer and the ministry of the Word to deal with a disagreement in the early Church (Acts 6:2ff). He tempted them by encouraging them to do a good and needed work. Moreover, the devil didn't tell them to completely quit their ministry of the Word but only to cut back just for a little while. However, once we deviate even slightly from our God-given call (even if we do it by performing good deeds), we are no longer doing God's will. When we give an inch even for a moment, our inch turns into miles which can last forever.

Therefore:

Do God's deeds, not good deeds.

Do nothing but His will.

Don't interrupt or postpone God's work. Do it now.

Don't let up at all in proclaiming His Word in season and out of season (2 Tm 4:2).

**Prayer:** Father, by Your grace I will live my vocation to the full.

**Promise:** "Do not let your hearts be troubled. Have faith in God and faith in Me." —Jn 14:1

**Praise:** Praise You, risen Jesus, our Brother, for raising us to new life in You. Thanks be to God!

#### THE CUP OF LIFE | Henri Nouwen Society

When the mother of James and John asks Jesus to give her sons a special place in his Kingdom, Jesus responds, "Can you drink the cup that I am going to drink?" (Matthew 20:22). "Can we drink the cup?" is the most challenging and radical question we can ask ourselves. The cup is the cup of life, full of sorrows and joys. Can we hold our cups and claim them as our own? Can we lift our cups to offer blessings to others, and can we drink our cups to the bottom as cups that bring us salvation?

Keeping this question alive in us is one of the most demanding spiritual exercises we can practice.

#### HOLDING THE CUP | Henri Nouwen Society

We all must hold the cups of our lives. As we grow older and become more fully aware of the many sorrows of life - personal failures, family conflicts, disappointments in work and social life, and the many pains surrounding us on the national and international scene - everything within and around us conspires to make us ignore, avoid, suppress, or simply deny these sorrows. "Look at the sunny side of life and make the best of it," we say to ourselves and hear others say to us. But when we want to drink the cups of our lives, we need first to hold them, to fully acknowledge what we are living, trusting that by not avoiding but befriending our sorrows we will discover the true joy we are looking for right in the midst of our sorrows.

#### SEEING THE MIRACLE OF MULTIPLICATION | Henri Nouwen Society

The opposite of a scarcity mentality is an abundancy mentality. With an abundancy mentality we say: "There is enough for everyone, more than enough: food, knowledge, love ... everything." With this mind-set we give away whatever we have, to whomever we meet. When we see hungry people we give them food. When we meet ignorant people we share our knowledge; when we encounter people in need of love, we offer them friendship and affection and hospitality and introduce them to our family and friends.

When we live with this mind-set, we will see the miracle that what we give away multiplies: food, knowledge, love ... everything. There will even be many leftovers.

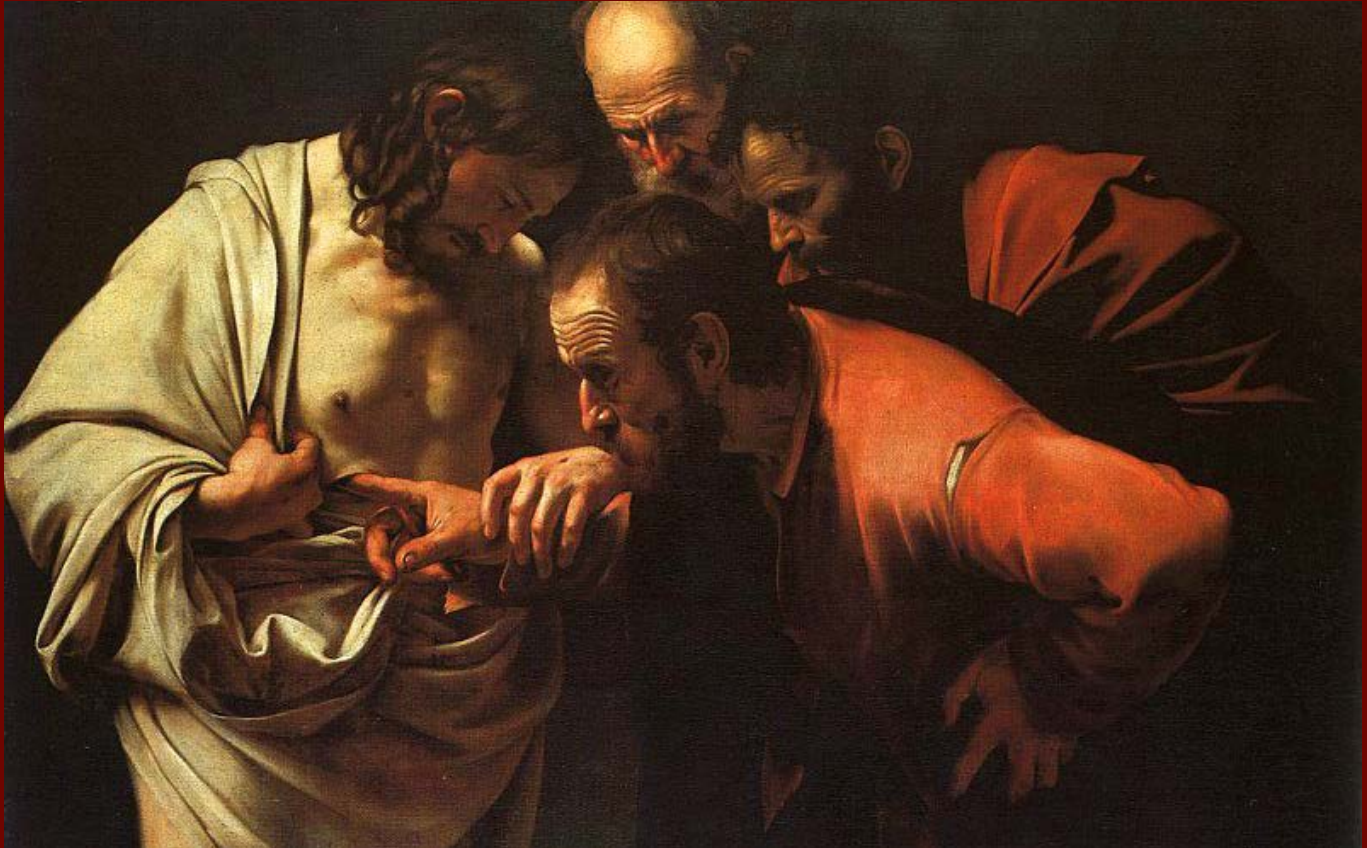

**LA TENTACIÓN DE HACER EL BIEN**

**“De esa manera, podremos dedicarnos a la oración y al ministerio de la Palabra”**

**(Hechos 6, 4).**

La palabra de Dios no está encadenada (2 Tim 2, 9); pero los mensajeros de la palabra de Dios pueden ser encadenados. A menudo, estamos encadenados por el pecado, el egoísmo o el miedo. Sin embargo, podemos ser encadenados de maneras más sutiles. Por ejemplo, el diablo trató de encadenar a los apóstoles, haciéndoles pensar que necesitaban reducir temporalmente la oración y el ministerio de la Palabra, para hacer frente a un desacuerdo en la Iglesia primitiva (Hch 6, 2ss). Los tentó, animándoles a hacer una obra buena y necesaria. Además, el diablo no les dijo que abandonaran por completo su ministerio de la Palabra, sino que solamente lo recortaran por un tiempo. Sin embargo, una vez que nos desviamos un poco, de nuestro llamado dado por Dios (incluso si lo hacemos mediante la realización de buenas acciones); ya no estamos haciendo la voluntad de Dios. Cuando damos una pulgada siquiera por un momento, nuestra pulgada se convierte en millas que pueden durar para siempre.

Por lo tanto:

Haz las obras de Dios, no buenas obras.

No hagas otra cosa, sino Su voluntad.

No interrumpas o pospongas el trabajo de Dios.

Hazlo ahora.

No dejes de proclamar del todo su Palabra a tiempo y fuera de tiempo (2 Tim 4, 2).

**Oración:** Padre, por Tu gracia voy a vivir mi vocación a plenitud.

**Promesa:** "No se inquieten. Crean en Dios y crean también en Mí" (Jn 14, 1).
