## REFLECTIONS

### DO NOT LOSE HEART (LK 18:1)

“This widow is wearing me out.” —Luke 18:5

If the unjust judge, who tends toward evil, and who simply wants the powerless widow to go away, will relent and render her justice (Lk 18:3-5), how much more will the Just Judge, the Lord, act rightly.

We give the forces of evil so much credit. Evil strongholds seem indestructible to us (see Nm 13:31-33; 1 Sm 17:11). Yet evil is prone to imploding and bringing about its own destruction (see e.g. Jgs 7:19-22). The kingdom of God will outlast the forces of evil and emerge victorious (see 1 Jn 4:4). Even if we, God's soldiers, wear out, God will protect His property (Ps 46:6).

Jesus wonders if there will be any faith when He returns (Lk 18:8). In the context of this parable, Jesus is also wondering if He will find any persistence at the time of His return. Be the answer to Jesus' search for faith.

“Fix your eyes on Jesus” (Heb 3:1). Persevere. Persist. Have confident faith in His power and loving-kindness. Do not lose heart (Lk 18:1).

**Prayer:** Lord, “increase our faith” (Lk 17:5). Give us a steadfast, persevering, persistent faith to defeat the forces of evil.

**Promise:** “Happy the man who fears the Lord, who greatly delights in His commands.” —Ps 112:1

**Praise:** St. Josaphat worked diligently to restore unity between the Catholic and Eastern Orthodox Churches. He produced catechisms and other works promoting dialogue between the two groups.

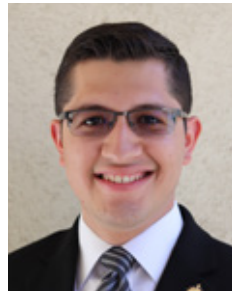

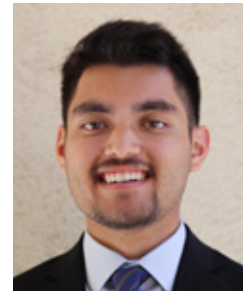

### SIN DESANIMARSE (LC 18:1)

#### "Esta viuda me molesta" (Lucas 18:5)

Si un juez injusto, quien hace mal y quien simplemente quiere que la viuda se vaya, cede y provee justicia a ella (Lc 18:3-5), entonces el Juez Justo, el Señor, con más razón actuará correctamente.

Damos demasiado crédito a las fuerzas del mal. Las fortalezas del mal nos parecen indestructibles (ver Núm 13:31-33; 1 Sm 17:11). Sin embargo, la maldad es propensa a surgir y causar su propia destrucción (ver Jue 7:19-22). El reino de Dios sobrevivirá a las fuerzas de la maldad y saldrá victorioso (ver 1 Jn 4:4). Aun si nosotros, los soldados de Dios nos desgastamos, Dios protegerá Su propiedad (Sal 46:6).

Jesús se pregunta si existirá fe cuando Él regrese (Lc 18:8). En el contexto de esta parábola, Jesús también se pregunta si encontrará persistencia en el momento de Su regreso. Sé tú la respuesta a la búsqueda de Jesús por fe.

Fija sus ojos en Jesús (Heb 3:1). Persevera. Persiste. Ten fe en Su poder y bondad. No se desanime (Lc 18:1).

**Oración:** Señor, "aumentanos la fe" (Lc 17:5). Danos una fe firme, perseverante, y persistente para vencer las fuerzas de la mal.

**Promesa:** "Feliz el hombre que teme al Señor y se complace en sus mandamientos" (Sal 112:1).

**Alabanza:** San Josafat trabajó duramente para restaurar la unidad entre la Iglesia Católica y la Iglesia Ortodoxa Oriental. Él hizo catequesis y otras obras para promover el dialogo entre los dos grupos.

### "...el Rey del universo nos resucitará a una vida eterna" (2 Macabeos 7:9).

Tanto la primera lectura como el Evangelio de hoy nos hablan sobre la vida después de la muerte. Ambos muestran que los humanos no tenemos idea de cómo será la vida resucitada. En el Evangelio de hoy, los saduceos lo demuestran con sus suposiciones equivocadas. Fueron "gravemente engañados" y fallaron al "no comprender las Escrituras ni el poder de Dios" (Mc 12:24).

La resurrección de Jesucristo es un hecho histórico. No es simplemente una idea. A lo largo de los siglos posteriores a la resurrección de Jesús, muchos han dado su vida en martirio para defender la verdad de la resurrección de Jesús.

Numerosos mártires "se dejaron torturar, renunciando a ser liberados, para obtener una mejor resurrección" (Heb 11:35).

La clave de la vida es el encuentro con Jesús resucitado. Después de habernos encontrado con Cristo resucitado, nos convertimos en "una nueva criatura: lo antiguo ha desaparecido, un ser nuevo se ha hecho presente" (2 Co 5:17). Incluso en esta vida terrenal, nuestro estilo de vida cambia por completo cuando vemos todo a través de la perspectiva del reino de Dios en lugar de hacerlo con los ojos del mundo (ver Mt 6:19-34).

Puesto que Jesús ha resucitado, los bautizados en Cristo podemos participar ahora de esta vida resucitada (Col 1:10-13). Nuestra vida está escondida en Cristo (Col 3:3). Somos ciudadanos del cielo (Fil 3:20) mientras vivimos en esta tierra. Acepta a Jesús resucitado como tu Señor.

**Oración:** Padre, que tenga mucha más confianza en la resurrección de Jesucristo que la que tengo en principios terrenales como la ley de la gravedad.

**Promesa:** "Pero el Señor es fiel: él los fortalecerá y los preservará del Maligno" (2 Tes 3:3).

**Alabanza:** "Porque si nos hemos identificado con Cristo por una muerte semejante a la suya, también nos identificaremos con Él en la resurrección" (Rom 6:5). Alabado seas, Jesús resucitado.
