## REFLECTIONS

### WHAT'S THE SMOKE FOR?

Dear Johan,

I can't believe what people are wearing to church these days. Can't you do something about that?

Gentle Reader,

Believe me, I have tried, but people just don't like to be told what to wear. That will, however, not keep me from opining on the matter.

Shortly before I moved to the United States I was invited to join a group of other soon-to-be expats for an evening at the Belgian-American Foundation. The goal of the evening was to facilitate the transition from life in Europe to life in the United States. In addition to teaching us how to shop we were told what to wear. One of the points the American instructor made was that Europeans are much more formal than Americans. So, we were advised not to bring too many suits and formal outfits. Over the past 25 years, I have realized, however, that even if the majority of Americans are less formal than Europeans, there are different levels of informality. People tend to wear specific clothes to different events. Baseball games, picnics, fine dinners, and Sunday Eucharist require their own sets of clothes. Recently I have noticed, though, that some people come to church wearing Viking purple or Packer green. I suppose I should take consolation in the absence of the fake Viking hair and hats.

The reason for wearing certain clothes for certain occasions, be they formal or informal, is that clothes not only cover the body but they also communicate a message, whether intended or not. Most important they communicate how the wearer feels about the event that takes place.

And of course, you are correct: there is indeed appropriate and inappropriate dress for worship, especially for liturgical ministers. Last week one of our servers wore tennis shoes that light up at every step. These were inappropriate for two reasons. First, tennis shoes should be worn for tennis and not for church. Second, they were distracting to the assembly. Rather than gazing at the cross the server was carrying, parishioners stared at his fancy footwear.

I know that the last thing people want me to say is that their outfit is inappropriate for church. So I won't. But just so you know, when I get up on Sunday morning and decide what to wear, I always ask myself if my attire is fitting for the celebration of the Eucharist, rather than mindlessly throwing on shorts, a Grateful Dead T-shirt, and flip-flops.

### TWO WAYS

#### “Instruct me.” — Psalm 119:33

There are two ways of life, and God has given us freedom to make our own choice. “Before man are life and death, whichever he chooses shall be given him” (Sir 15:17). Yet He gives us every instruction needed to say “Yes” to God's way and “No” to Satan's way. So the Church leads us to pray with the psalmist in today's psalm response, “Instruct me” (Ps 119:33). We need to beg the Lord for His instruction because we have been entrusted with the power to choose.

There is no neutrality in this choice. So it is important to instruct those under our spiritual care before letting them make that choice. This applies particularly to our children. The world will instruct people via Satan, and will do so loudly and with pressure. We Christians must likewise instruct these people, and do so with the loving heart of the Good Shepherd (see Mt 11:29). As you instruct, do so with love.

We have the freedom to choose our own eternal destruction. We have the freedom to choose eternal joy and to have influence in the salvation of our loved ones by our life of trust in God. The Lord declares: “I have today set before you life and prosperity, death and doom...Choose life” (Dt 30:15, 19).

**Prayer:** Father, “open my eyes, that I may consider the wonders of Your law” (Ps 119:18).

**Promise:** “Eye has not seen, ear has not heard, nor has it so much as dawned on man what God has prepared for those who love Him.” —1 Cor 2:9

**Praise:** Praise You, risen Jesus, Wisdom of God! (1 Cor 1:30)

## REFLEXIONES

### DOS CAMINOS

#### “Instrúyeme” (Salmos 119:34).

Hay dos caminos de vida, y Dios nos ha dado libertad para hacer nuestra propia elección. “Ante los hombres están la vida y la muerte: a cada uno se le dará lo que prefiera” (Ecl 15:17). Sin embargo, Él nos da todas las instrucciones necesarias para decir "Sí" al camino de Dios y "No" al camino de Satanás. Así que la Iglesia nos lleva a orar con el salmista en la respuesta al salmo de hoy, “Instrúyeme” (Sal 119:34). Necesitamos rogar al Señor por Su instrucción porque se nos ha confiado el poder de elegir.

No hay neutralidad en esta elección. Por lo tanto, es importante instruir a quienes están bajo nuestro cuidado espiritual antes de permitirles tomar esa decisión. Esto se aplica particularmente a nuestros hijos. El mundo instruirá a la gente por medio de Satanás, y lo hará en voz alta y con presión. Los cristianos también debemos instruir a estas personas, y hacerlo con el corazón amoroso del Buen Pastor (ver Mt 11:29). Cuando instruya, hágalo con amor.

Tenemos la libertad de elegir nuestra propia destrucción eterna. Tenemos la libertad de elegir el gozo eterno y de influir en la salvación de nuestros seres queridos por nuestra vida de confianza en Dios. El Señor declara: “Hoy pongo delante de ti la vida y la felicidad, la muerte y la desdicha.... Elige la vida” (Dt 30:15, 19).

**Oración:** Padre, “Abre mis ojos, para que contemple las maravillas de Tu ley” (Sal 119:18).

**Promesa:** “Lo que nadie vio ni oyó y ni siquiera pudo pensar, aquello que Dios preparó para los que lo aman” (1 Co 2:9).

**Alabanza:** ¡Alabado seas, Jesús resucitado, Sabiduría de Dios! (1 Co 1:30)

### CEGUERA ESPIRITUAL

#### “Ustedes tienen la mente enceguecida. Tienen ojos y no ven, oídos y no oyen” (Marcos 8:17-18).

Jesús estaba horrorizado por la ceguera espiritual de Sus discípulos. Estaban cegados al significado de las dos multiplicaciones de los panes y los peces. Estaban cegados a quién era Jesús. Esta ceguera eventualmente llevaría a Sus discípulos a abandonar a Jesús en el Calvario.

La ceguera espiritual causó la muerte de Jesús en la cruz. Causó el Tercer Reich, el Holocausto de seis millones de judíos, la esclavitud durante siglos e innumerables otras atrocidades. La ceguera espiritual causa hambre, racismo, abuso sexual de niños, asesinatos masivos por aborto.

La ceguera espiritual es causada por el dios de la era presente (2 Co 4:4) y por nuestra complicidad con los males de este dios del egoísmo y del humanismo secular. La ceguera espiritual es causada por el pecado. Las tinieblas del pecado nos ciegan (1 Jn 2:11), nos ciegan y no nos dejan ver que estamos ciegos (Jn 9:40) y nos hacen cegarnos a nosotros mismos (ver Is 29:9). Naciones enteras, ciudades e incluso iglesias (ver Ap 3:17) pueden volverse espiritualmente ciegas.

Jesús ha dividido al mundo en dos grupos: los que se quedan ciegos y los que ven (Jn 9:39). Arrepiéntete, confíesate y deja que Jesús te sane de la ceguera.

**Oración:** Padre, por medio de mi celebración mensual del Sacramento de la Reconciliación, devuélveme la vista y evita que me quede ciego espiritualmente.

**Promesa:** “Noé fue agradable a los ojos del Señor” (Gn 6:8).
