**FIRST READING | Jos 24:1-2a, 15-17, 18b**

Joshua gathered together all the tribes of Israel at Shechem, summoning their elders, their leaders, their judges, and their officers. When they stood in ranks before God, Joshua addressed all the people: "If it does not please you to serve the LORD, decide today whom you will serve, the gods your fathers served beyond the River or the gods of the Amorites in whose country you are now dwelling. As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."  
But the people answered, "Far be it from us to forsake the LORD for the service of other gods. For it was the LORD, our God, who brought us and our fathers up out of the land of Egypt, out of a state of slavery. He performed those great miracles before our very eyes and protected us along our entire journey and among the peoples through whom we passed. Therefore we also will serve the LORD, for he is our God."

**SECOND READING | Eph 5:21-32**

Brothers and sisters: Be subordinate to one another out of reverence for Christ. Wives should be subordinate to their husbands as to the Lord. For the husband is head of his wife just as Christ is head of the church, he himself the savior of the body. As the church is subordinate to Christ, so wives should be subordinate to their husbands in everything. Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ loved the church and handed himself over for her to sanctify her, cleansing her by the bath of water with the word, that he might present to himself the church in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. So also husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one hates his own flesh but rather nourishes and cherishes it, even as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body.

*For this reason a man shall leave his father and his mother*

*and be joined to his wife,*

*and the two shall become one flesh.*

This is a great mystery, but I speak in reference to Christ and the church.

**Your words, Lord, are Spirit and life; you have the words of everlasting life.**

**GOSPEL | Jn 6:60-69**

Many of Jesus' disciples who were listening said, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" Since Jesus knew that his disciples were murmuring about this, he said to them, "Does this shock you? What if you were to see the Son of Man ascending to where he was before? It is the spirit that gives life, while the flesh is of no avail. The words I have spoken to you are Spirit and life. But there are some of you who do not believe." Jesus knew from the beginning the ones who would not believe and the one who would betray him. And he said, "For this reason *(cont)*

*(cont)* I have told you that no one can come to me unless it is granted him by my Father.”  
 As a result of this, many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him. Jesus then said to the Twelve, “Do you also want to leave?” Simon Peter answered him, “Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God.”

**SHEPHERDS FIELD OLIVE WOOD HANDCRAFTS**  
**September 4-5**

“A group from the Holy Land (Bethlehem & Jerusalem) will be selling religious articles after masses to support the Catholic Christian minorities in Bethlehem. As a tradition, many of the Catholic families in the Holy Land work in small workshops to produce religious articles from olive wood. These articles represent the Christian art of the Holy Land. In the past, they used to sell their artwork to pilgrims who visit the Holy Land. However, these days they are facing an economic hardship, as there are no tourists at all can visit the Holy Land due to pandemic. Many of the Catholic families immigrated and left the Holy Land. The percentage of Christians in the Holy Land has dropped from 20% to less than 1%. Therefore, if this hardship continues as it is now, we believe that in a few years, there will be no Catholics in Bethlehem or Jerusalem. The struggle to preserve the Catholic identity of the birthplace of our savior; Jesus Christ is a serious concern for Catholics around the world. Sales will be used to help and support the Catholics in the Holy Land and to encourage them not to immigrate.”

### ARE YOU READY?

**“You must be prepared.” —Matthew 24:44**

Jesus is coming back to take us with Him (Jn 14:3). No one can know the exact day or hour of Jesus’ return (Mt 24:42). He will return at the time we least expect (Mt 24:44). Therefore, we must be always ready. We are ready for Jesus’ second and final coming when:

- 1) We are faithful, farsighted servants (Mt 24:45).
- 2) We are working to feed people physically and/or spiritually (Mt 24:46).
- 3) Our hearts have been strengthened and made blameless and holy (1 Thes 3:13).
- 4) We have accepted Jesus’ salvation (2 Pt 3:15).
- 5) We are “without stain or defilement, and at peace” in God’s sight (2 Pt 3:14).
- 6) We are singing and praising the Lord (see Rv 19:1ff).
- 7) We are “pure and follow the Lamb [Jesus] wherever He goes” (Rv 14:4).
- 8) We have washed our robes in the blood of the Lamb and survived the great period of trial (Rv 7:14).
- 9) We have guarded our spirits against “indulgence and drunkenness and worldly cares” (Lk 21:34).
- 10) We are praying constantly (Lk 21:36; cf 1 Thes 5:17).

Are you ready for Jesus to come back now? Maranatha! “Come, Lord Jesus!” (Rv 22:20)

### A GROWTH-SPURT

**“It is God’s will that you grow in holiness.” —1 Thessalonians 4:3**

The Lord told Paul to tell the Thessalonian Christians to grow in holiness (see 1 Thes 4:3) and to please God by their conduct even more than before (1 Thes 4:1). The Lord expects and delights to see His children grow holy in every aspect of their conduct (1 Pt 1:15).

In fact, the Lord probably wants us to have a growth spurt in the last part of this year. Little children and teenagers commonly grow several inches in a short time. Likewise, we who are God’s children can grow in holiness in a greatly accelerated way. The Lord delights to see His children grow quickly to great levels of holiness.

Because we love the Lord, we want to please Him by growing holy as deeply and as quickly as possible. Let us commit ourselves today to obey the Lord in any and every way so as to grow holy. Let us live, suffer, and die for holiness. May holiness be the greatest desire of our hearts because it is the greatest desire of the Lord’s heart.

### STOP THE EXPANSION OF ABORTION IN CALIFORNIA. STOP SB 245

Bishop Soto invites every Catholic in the Diocese of Sacramento to write or call their state representatives during the week of August 23-27, 2021, to oppose SB 245. This bill expands abortion by removing deductibles, co-payments, and other cost-sharing. SB 245 will make only one "choice" more accessible for women in California: the abortion of an unborn child. At the same time, prenatal care and post-natal services continue to have significant co-pays and deductible costs. Reducing the co-pay for abortions urges women, usually those who are poor and isolated, to choose abortion in the absence of any alternative support to bring their child to birth. Women and their children deserve better.

## REFLECTIONS

### KNOW BODY | “Do you believe just because...” —John 1:50

“When Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward Him, He remarked: ‘This man is a true Israelite. There is no guile in him’ ” (Jn 1:47). Nathanael asked Jesus, “How do You know me?” (Jn 1:48) This is a revealing response. The typical response to a total stranger would be to ask: “How do you know this information about me?” Yet Nathanael asked: “How do You know me?” The brief encounter between Nathanael and Jesus resulted in a supernatural knowledge, a binding of hearts, a joining of the divine and the human. Nathanael (Bartholomew) had an instant personal encounter with Christ and realized that Jesus knew him, loved him, and was the Son of God! (Jn 1:49)

Jesus made a comment which is also revealing. He asked if Nathanael came to believe just because He encountered Jesus personally (Jn 1:50). A life-changing personal encounter with Jesus is absolutely critical. However, Jesus went on to say that Nathanael would see much greater things than that! (Jn 1:50) He would see the glory of heaven (Jn 1:51). He would see the glory of the Church, the new Jerusalem (Rv 21:9ff). He would be chosen as an apostle (Mk 3:18), the foundation of the Body of Christ, the Church (Eph 2:20; Rv 21:14; Col 1:18). Nathanael would see Jesus as not just his Lord, but as Lord of heaven and earth. May we all encounter Jesus personally and accept Him as our Lord and Savior. Then may we all accept Him for everything that He truly is, in all His glory and splendor.

**Prayer:** *Jesus, may I love the Church as You do (Eph 5:25).*

**Promise:** *“The Lord is near to all who call upon Him; to all who call upon Him in truth.” —Ps 145:18*

**Praise:** *St. Bartholomew renounced his prejudice toward Nazoreans and accepted Jesus the Nazorean as his Lord (see Jn 1:49).*

Hermanos: Respétense unos a otros, por reverencia a Cristo: que las mujeres respeten a sus maridos, como si se tratara del Señor, porque el marido es cabeza de la mujer, como Cristo es cabeza y salvador de la Iglesia, que es su cuerpo. Tú tienes palabras de vida eterna; y nosotros creemos y sabemos que tú eres el Santo de Dios”.

### BENDITA SUMISIÓN

**“Así como la Iglesia está sometida a Cristo, de la misma manera las mujeres deben respetar en todo a su marido” (Efesios 5:24).**

Este pasaje de las Escrituras es uno de los más incomprendidos en la Biblia. La sumisión es una palabra impopular en nuestra cultura contemporánea. En la Biblia, la sumisión es muy valorada. Es la posición de Jesús en la cruz (ver Fil 2:8). La sumisión es el camino de la redención y el poder de Dios. No es una posición de debilidad; más bien, es una de fuerza sobrenatural. La sumisión no es pasividad; es una obediencia activa y amorosa, incluso en el desacuerdo.

Debemos someternos al Señor, a Su Palabra y a Su Iglesia (Ef 5:21). Debemos ser sumisos a los pastores, padres, esposos, gobiernos y líderes (Ef 5:21; ver Rom 13:7). Si las autoridades se contradicen mutuamente, nos sometemos a la autoridad superior. Por ejemplo, si el gobierno contradice la Biblia, obedecemos la Biblia y, en consecuencia, desobedecemos al gobierno. Sin embargo, la mayoría de las veces nos sometemos a ellos, nos negamos a nosotros mismos, tomamos la cruz y seguimos los pasos de Jesús (Lc 9:23).

**Oración:** Padre, dame la fortaleza para aceptar el privilegio de la sumisión. **Promesa:** “Yo y mi familia serviremos al Señor” (Jos 24:15). **Alabanza:** “El que come Mi carne y bebe Mi sangre tiene Vida eterna, y Yo lo resucitaré en el último día” (Jn 6:54). La típica manera de responder a un extraño sería: “¿Cómo sabes esta información sobre mí?” Sin embargo, Natanael le preguntó “¿De dónde me conoces?” El breve encuentro entre Natanael y Jesús resultó en un conocimiento sobrenatural, un lazo entre corazones, la unión de lo divino y lo humano. Natanael (Bartolomé) tuvo un encuentro personal instantáneo con Cristo y se dio cuenta que Jesús lo conocía, que lo amaba y que era el Hijo de Dios (Jn 1:49).

Jesús hizo un comentario que también es revelador. Le preguntó a Natanael si él creía solo porque tuvo un encuentro personal con Jesús (Jn 1:50). Un encuentro personal y transformador con Jesús es absolutamente importante. Sin embargo, Jesús dijo que Natanael vería cosas mucho más grandes que eso (Jn 1:50). Vería la gloria del cielo (Jn 1:51). Vería la gloria de la Iglesia, la nueva Jerusalén (Ap 21:9ss). Sería escogido como un apóstol (Mc 3:18), el fundamento del Cuerpo de Cristo, la Iglesia (Ef 2:20; Ap 21:14; Col 1:18). Natanael vería a Jesús no solo como su Señor, sino como el Señor del cielo y la tierra. Que todos tengamos un encuentro personal con Jesús y lo aceptemos como nuestro Señor y Salvador. Y que lo aceptemos por todo lo que verdaderamente es, en Su gloria y esplendor.

**Oración:** Jesús, permíteme que ame a la Iglesia como Tú la amas (Ef 5:25). **Promesa:** “El Señor está cerca de aquellos que lo invocan, de aquellos que lo invocan de verdad” (Sal 145:18).
