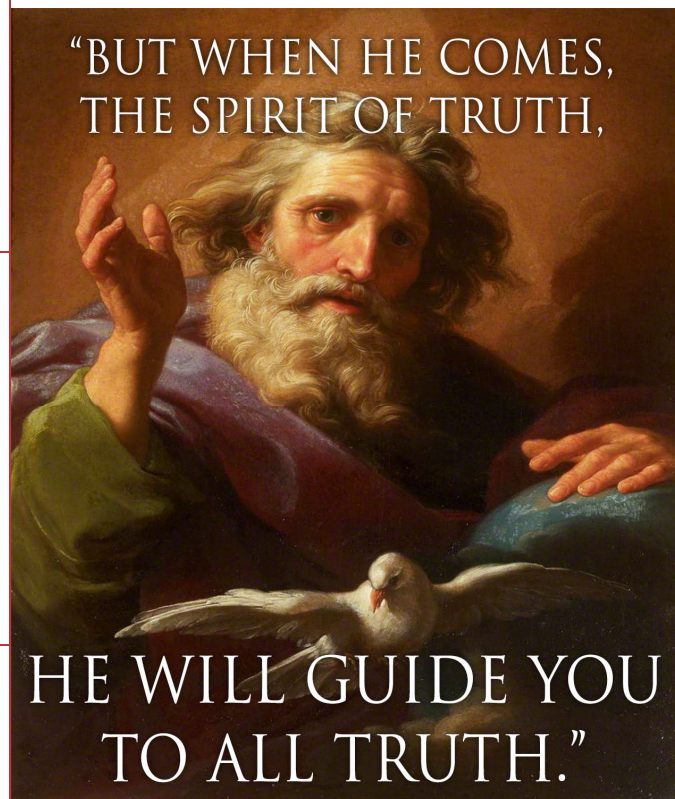

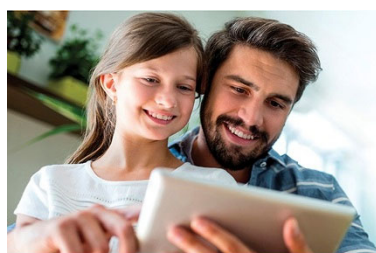

REFLECTIONS

WITH ENEMIES LIKE THIS, WHO NEEDS FRIENDS? “...my enemy,’ Ahab said to Elijah.” —1 Kings 21:20

How good to have an enemy like Elijah the prophet! Elijah prophesied to his enemy, Ahab (1 Kgs 21:19ff). Those prophetic words cut to Ahab’s heart and led him to repentance and fasting (1 Kgs 21:27). Ahab’s heartfelt reaction to the prophecy of his enemy even spared him from destruction during his lifetime (1 Kgs 21:29). “For if a man meets his enemy, does he send him away unharmed?” (1 Sm 24:20) Or does a man send his enemy away blessed, prayed for, and enriched? Elijah, the enemy, sent Ahab home repentant and spared from destruction.

The litmus test of a Christian is to love one’s enemies (Mt 5:44). “This will prove that you are [children] of your heavenly Father” (Mt 5:45). Even should our enemies persecute us, we are called to imitate Jesus by forgiving them and praying for them. Finally, we lay down our life for our enemies out of love. Acting in this way leads us to be “made perfect,” as our heavenly Father is perfect (Mt 5:48).

Take a moment and think of two people who have hurt you the most. Beg God for the extraordinary grace required to love these two people. With Jesus, say: “Father, forgive them; they do not know what they are doing” (Lk 23:34). Repent of any hatred of enemies.

Prayer: Father, may I treat my enemies as Jesus did: praying for them, forgiving them, and laying down my life for them (Rm 5:8, 10).

Promise: You must be made perfect as your heavenly Father is perfect.” —Mt 5:48

Praise: When Patricia allowed the Holy Spirit to be stirred into flame in her life, she experienced Jesus’ promise of true life in abundance (Jn 10:10).

ABBA

“Our Father...” —Matthew 6:9

“The expression ‘God the Father’ had never been revealed to anyone” before Jesus taught us to pray “Our Father” (Catechism of the Catholic Church, 2779). When Jesus taught His disciples to pray the Our Father, He used a word for Father, “Abba,” that can be translated as “Daddy.” Addressing God as Father only occurs a very few times in the Old Testament (e.g. Is 64:7). So those who originally heard Jesus teach them the Our Father must have been shocked. Even today, many wounded people admit that they cannot relate to God as gentle and loving because they did not receive tender, merciful love from their own earthly fathers. Accordingly, they perceive God as distant and uncaring.

Nonetheless, Jesus reveals God as “Our Father.” He wants to bring people to a proper relationship with the Father. Jesus reveals to us: “Your Father knows what you need before you ask Him” (Mt 6:8). Jesus teaches us to call God “Our Father” (Mt 6:9), Who is such a loving Father and Provider. “God loves His people more than a bridegroom his beloved” (Catechism, 219).

Can you believe that your Father in heaven loves you so much that He would send His only begotten Son to die for your salvation? (Jn 3:16-17) Surrender your life to God the Father. Love Him with all your heart, soul, strength, and mind (Lk 10:27).

Prayer: Holy Spirit, cry out in my heart “Abba, Father” (see Gal 4:6; Rm 8:15).

Promise: “If you forgive the faults of others, your heavenly Father will forgive you yours. If you do not forgive others, neither will your Father forgive you.” —Mt 6:14-15

Praise: Stan kept witnessing to Holly, a hardhearted teen, although she showed no sign of a change of heart. Holly is now in full-time ministry for Jesus.

MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS REPORT

Dear parishioners of Saint Theresa,
Please find below a list of the main maintenance and improvement items done in the last seven years in all the buildings.

GRACE HALL

- New boiler to heat the building
- New hot water boiler
- The storage rooms were painted, and new floor was installed in one of them
- New carpet was installed and removed later and used in the hallway of the Faith Formation Center
- The basketball hoops were removed
- The wood floors in the hall were refinished
- The hall was painted
- New floor in the kitchen was installed
- The parish acquired an ice machine maker
- The exterior of the building was painted
- Some new tables and new chairs were purchased
- The front outdoor carpet of the hall was replaced
- A new backlit cross facing the highway was added to the building (donated)
- The New visible freestanding Saint Theresa Sign on the corner of Lyons Avenue and South Lake Tahoe Boulevard was added
- The garbage disposal was replaced

THE GARAGE/STORAGE FOR BREAD AND BROTH

- New garage doors

RECTORY

- Two new garage doors (donated)
- The lead abatement was taken care of
- The exterior and interior of the building was painted
- A new boiler was installed
- A new hot water boiler was installed
- All the blinds were replaced
- New light fixtures were installed
- Ceiling fans were added to some of the bedrooms
- The wallpaper was removed from some of the rooms and bathrooms
- The popcorn ceiling was removed from some rooms
- All the toilets were replaced
- Some of the vanities, vanity tops and mirrors were replaced
- A new refrigerator, a new oven, a new washing machine and dryer were bought to replace the very old and failing ones
- The back yard was redone by some of the Knights of Columbus
- The grassy area was planted by some parishioners who have since left the parish

MAIN OFFICE

- The main office is being remodeled
- An exterior accessible ramp is being installed

CHURCH BUILDING

- The exterior of the church was painted
- The carpet under the candles was replaced with rock flooring
- New exit/emergency lights were installed
- A new boiler was installed
- The heating control system was installed
- A new fire panel was put in place
- The bell and cross left from the Chapel burnt in the Caldor Fire were installed (Bob Attinger and team)
- New blinds were installed
- The new carpet in the church will be installed in next few weeks
- The security cameras were installed

GLOBIN HALL

- Globin Hall was redone after the pine tree collapsed on top of the building in December 2014. This was a work in progress in 2015.
- Some new tables and new chairs were purchased

PARKING LOTS AND GROUNDS

- The sealing and restriping of the parking lots are done every other year
- Several trees were removed from the property
- The garden beds were renewed, and several perennial plants added as well as many annuals every year
- The wood light poles were replaced with metal light poles

FAITH FORMATION CENTER

- A new boiler to heat up the building
- New light fixtures were installed
- A new roof replaced the old
- The bathrooms, the hallway, the RCIA room, the meeting room and offices were painted
- New floor was put in the RCIA room as well as new carpet in the new meeting room and office.
- The bathroom in the RCIA room was remodeled
- The old carpet that was in Grace Hall was installed in the hallway
- One of the classrooms was made the storage room for parish events and decorations

THE FORMER CONVENT

- The lead abatement was taken care of
- The exterior of the building was painted

- Se agregó el nuevo letrero visible de Santa Teresa en la esquina de Lyons Avenue y South Lake Tahoe Boulevard
- Se reemplazó el triturador de basura

RECTORÍA

- Dos puertas de garaje nuevas (donadas)
- Se removió el plomo encontrado en el edificio
- Se pintó el exterior e interior del edificio
- Se instaló un nuevo boiler para calentar el edificio
- Se instaló un boiler nuevo para el agua caliente
- Se cambiaron todas las persianas
- Se instalaron nuevos artefactos de iluminación
- Se agregaron ventiladores de techo a algunos de los dormitorios
- Se quitó el papel tapiz de algunas de las habitaciones y baños
- Se eliminó el techo de palomitas en algunas habitaciones
- Todos los baños fueron reemplazados
- Se reemplazaron algunos de los tocadores, tapas de tocadores y espejos
- Se compró un refrigerador nuevo, un horno nuevo, una lavadora y una secadora nuevas para reemplazar las muy viejas y defectuosas
- El patio trasero fue renovado por algunos de los Caballeros de Colón
- El área de césped fue plantada por algunos feligreses que desde entonces abandonaron la parroquia
