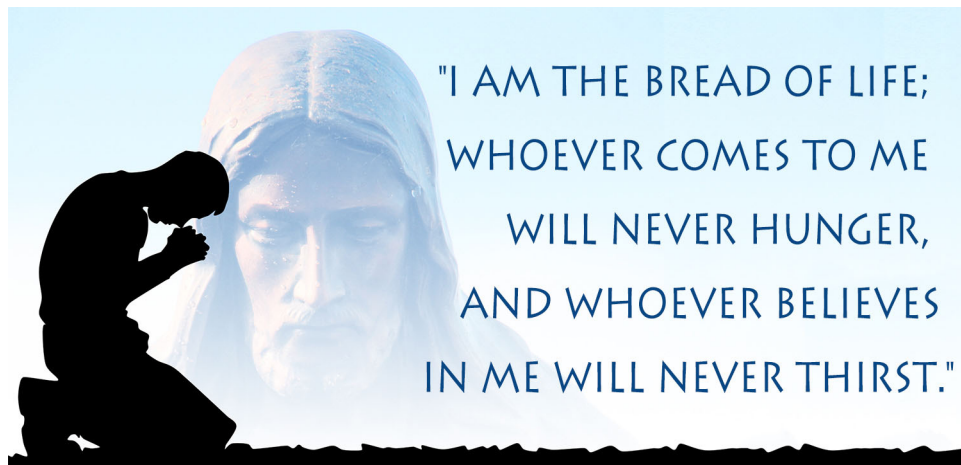

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GLORIA

FIRST READING | Ex 16:2-4, 12-15

The whole Israelite community grumbled against Moses and Aaron. The Israelites said to them, "Would that we had died at the LORD's hand in the land of Egypt, as we sat by our fleshpots and ate our fill of bread! But you had to lead us into this desert to make the whole community die of famine!"

Then the LORD said to Moses, "I will now rain down bread from heaven for you. Each day the people are to go out and gather their daily portion; thus will I test them, to see whether they follow my instructions or not.

"I have heard the grumbling of the Israelites. Tell them: In the evening twilight you shall eat flesh, and in the morning you shall have your fill of bread, so that you may know that I, the LORD, am your God."

In the evening quail came up and covered the camp. In the morning a dew lay all about the camp, and when the dew evaporated, there on the surface of the desert were fine flakes like hoarfrost on the ground. On seeing it, the Israelites asked one another, "What is this?" for they did not know what it was. But Moses told them, "This is the bread that the LORD has given you to eat."

SECOND READING | Eph 4:17, 20-24

Brothers and sisters: I declare and testify in the Lord that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their minds; that is not how you learned Christ, assuming that you have heard of him and were taught in him, as truth is in Jesus, that you should put away the old self of your former way of life, corrupted through deceitful desires, and be renewed in the spirit of your minds, and put on the new self, created in God's way in righteousness and holiness of truth.

One does not live on bread alone, but by every word that comes forth from the mouth of God.

GOSPEL | Jn 6:24-35

When the crowd saw that neither Jesus nor his disciples were there, they themselves got into boats and came to Capernaum looking for Jesus. And when they found him across the sea they said to him, "Rabbi, when did you get here?" Jesus answered them and said, "Amen, amen, I say to you, you are looking for me not because you saw signs but because you ate the loaves and were filled. Do not work for food that perishes but for the food that endures for eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. For on him the Father, God, has set his seal." So they said to him, "What can we do to accomplish the works of God?" Jesus answered and said to them, "This is the work of God, that you believe in the one he sent." So they said to him, "What sign can you do, that we may see and believe in you? What can you do? Our ancestors ate manna in the desert, as it is written:
He gave them bread from heaven to eat."

So Jesus said to them, "Amen, amen, I say to you,

it was not Moses who gave the bread from heaven; my Father gives you the true bread from heaven. For the bread of God is that which comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.”

So they said to him, “Sir, give us this bread always.” Jesus said to them, “I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst.”

NICENE CREED

I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible. I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

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REFLECTIONS

EAT! EAT!

"He gave them bread from the heavens to eat." —John 6:31

Today's Gospel reading from the sixth chapter of John begins Jesus' famous Bread of Life discourse, which we read for four consecutive Sundays. There is a distinct, intentional progression in the words of Jesus regarding our response to this heavenly bread.

During the first part of the discourse, Jesus emphasizes that we must believe He is the Bread of Life. The word believe is used four times from verses 29 through 47. Jesus teaches that we must believe in Him, and accordingly, believe the truths He is revealing. "I Myself am the Bread of Life. No one who comes to Me shall ever be hungry, no one who believes in Me shall ever thirst" (Jn 6:35).

Jesus makes an abrupt, intentional transition in the last half of the discourse. He stops using the word "believe" and begins using verbs and nouns referring to eating and drinking. For nine consecutive verses, 50 through 58, the verbs eat and drink or nouns for food and drink are used. "If anyone eats this bread he shall live forever" (Jn 6:51). "If you do not eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you" (Jn 6:53). "The man who feeds on this bread shall live forever" (Jn 6:58).

Jesus clearly states that anyone who believes in Him will take the next step and eat His eucharistic flesh. His initial hearers understood exactly the progression Jesus was making; they just refused to obey and eat (Jn 6:60ff). What about you? What will you do in response to Jesus' clear words? "Unless you eat..."

Prayer: Father, every day, or as often as possible, I will open wide my mouth so You may fill it with the food of Your eucharistic body and blood (Ps 81:11, 17).

Promise: "He rained manna upon them for food and gave them heavenly bread." —Ps 78:24

Praise: Praise You, risen Jesus, for giving us the Holy Spirit and Yourself in the Eucharist. Alleluia!

DEEPER FAITH OR ELSE

"Jesus then said in reply, 'Woman, you have great faith! Your wish will come to pass.' That very moment her daughter got better." —Matthew 15:28

Because the Lord loves us (Jer 31:3), He wants to show us His mercy (Jer 31:3) by giving us rest (Jer 31:2) and restoration (Jer 31:4). To accept these expressions of His love, we must repent of our sins and let the Lord run our lives completely. This is done by faith, and the greater the faith, the better.

Pope St. John Paul II has observed that most of the mammoth problems we face in the culture of death are symptoms. The cause of abortion, starvation, violence, racism, family breakdown, ethnic hatred, and many other evils is a lack of faith. The crisis of faith is the cause of most other crises. Jesus' question remains:

"When the Son of Man comes, will He find faith on the earth?" (Lk 18:8, our translation)

If we cry out to Jesus, He will help our lack of faith (Mk 9:24). The Holy Spirit will build our faith through God's Word (Rm 10:17) and through the sufferings we endure in obeying His Word (see 1 Pt 1:6-7). Then, as men and women of faith, we will move mountains (Mt 17:20) and be victorious over the world (1 Jn 5:5). We are saved by grace through faith (Eph 2:8).

Prayer: ather, send the Holy Spirit to give me the gift (1 Cor 12:9) and fruit of faith (Gal 5:22).

Promise: "The Lord has delivered His people." —Jer 31:7

Praise: St. Dominic taught the Faith to those who misunderstood. His ideal was "to speak only of God or to God."

REFLECTIONS

VISIONARY?

"Write down the vision clearly upon the tablets, so that one can read it readily." —Habakkuk 2:2

The Lord has a great plan for all people, and each one of us has been given a glorious part in that plan (see Heb 11:40). When we recognize our part in God's plan, we have "the vision" (Hab 2:2). We should write down this vision as accurately as possible and discern the various circumstances of our lives accordingly. Many Christians have difficulties in getting the vision. They are ignorant of God's Word and therefore of God's plan and their part in that plan. This problem can be rectified by studying the Church's teachings (especially in the Catechism) and by studying the Bible.

Possibly the major difficulty in getting the vision is our lack of faith that we have been adopted as children of God and therefore are called to greatness. Satan accuses us night and day (Rv 12:10). He tries to get us to doubt that we are sons and daughters of God the Father (see Mt 4:3, 6). If we yield to these temptations, we believe that we are called to nothing but selfishness, pleasure-seeking, and trivial pursuits. Under these circumstances, we will never get the vision, for the vision is a call to greatness, not foolish selfishness. Therefore, hear the Spirit cry out in your heart "Abba" ("Father") (Rm 8:15). Then see the vision.

Prayer: *Father, I will not waste what remains of my earthly life on doing my own thing (1 Pt 4:2).*

Promise: *"Then Jesus reprimanded him, and the demon came out of him. That very moment the boy was cured." —Mt 17:18*

Praise: *St. Clare's faith was so strong that she founded a religious order that eventually included her mother and two sisters. God rewarded Clare by giving her a vision of Mass from her sickbed.*

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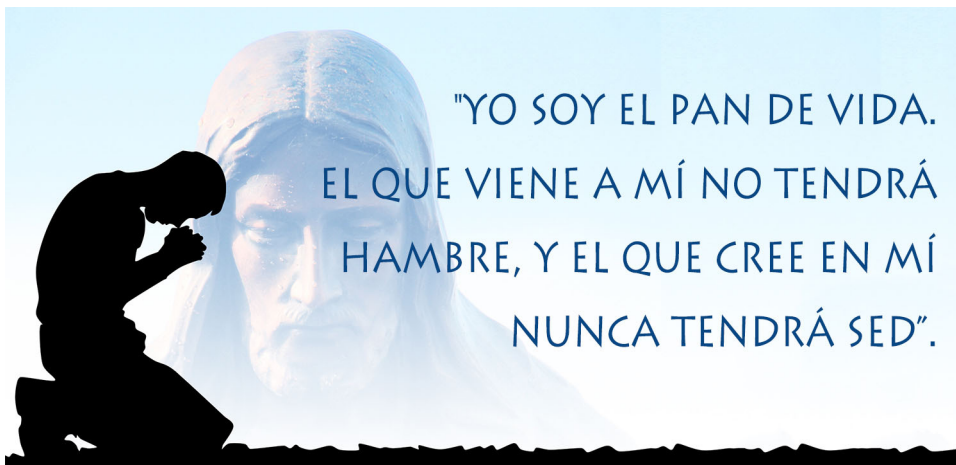

EVANGELIO | JN 6, 24-35

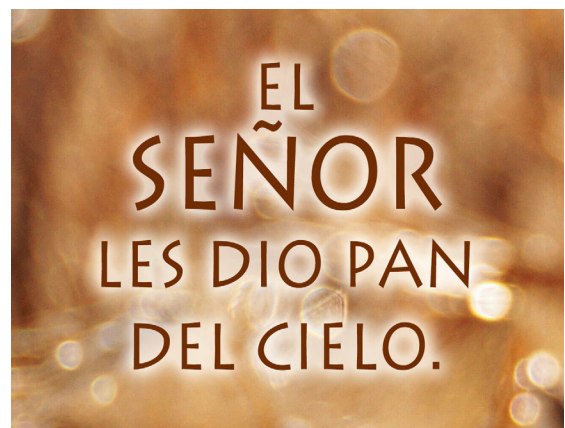

"Les dio de comer el pan bajado del cielo" (Juan 6:31).

La lectura del Evangelio de hoy del capítulo sexto de San Juan empieza con el famoso discurso de Jesús acerca del Pan de Vida, el cual vamos a leer durante cuatro domingos consecutivos. Hay una clara e intencionada progresión en las palabras de Jesús acerca de nuestra respuesta a este Pan celestial. En la primera parte del discurso, Jesús enfatiza que debemos creer que Él es el Pan de Vida. La palabra "creer" se usa cuatro veces desde el versículo 29 al 47. Jesús enseña que debemos creer en Él y, en consecuencia, creer las verdades que está revelando. "Yo soy el Pan de Vida. El que viene a Mí jamás tendrá hambre; el que cree en Mí jamás tendrá sed" (Jn 6:35). Jesús hace una transición abrupta e intencional en la segunda mitad del discurso. Deja de usar la palabra "creer" y empieza a usar verbos y nombres que se refieren al hecho de comer y beber. En los subsiguientes nueve versos, del 50 al 58, los verbos "comer y beber" o los nombres "comida y bebida" se usan repetidamente. "Si alguien come de este pan vivirá para siempre" (Jn 6:51). "Si no comen la carne del Hijo del hombre y no beben Su sangre, no tendrán Vida en ustedes" (Jn 6:53). "El que coma de este pan vivirá eternamente" (Jn 6:58). Jesús afirma claramente que cualquiera que crea en Él será capaz de dar el siguiente paso y comer Su carne eucarística. Sus primeros oyentes comprendieron exactamente la progresión que Jesús estaba realizando; pero rechazaron obedecer y comer (Jn 6:60ss). ¿Y tú? ¿Qué vas a hacer tú para responder a estas palabras de Jesús tan claras? "A menos que coman..."
Oración: Padre, todos los días, o tan menudo como sea posible, abriré bien la boca para que Tú la puedas llenar con la comida de Tu cuerpo y sangre eucarísticos (Sal 81:11, 17).
Promesa: "Hizo llover sobre ellos el maná, les dio como alimento un trigo celestial" (Sal 78:24).
Alabanza: Te alabamos, Cristo resucitado, por darnos al Espíritu Santo y a Ti mismo en la Eucaristía. ¡Aleluya!
