## REFLECTIONS

### INTENTIONS OF THE HOLY FATHER | June 2017 | National Leaders.

#### KNOW JESUS — NO FEAR "Do not fear." —Matthew 10:28

Jesus gives us at least four commandments in today's Gospel reading:

1. "Do not let them intimidate you" ([Mt 10:26](#)).
2. "Do not fear those who deprive the body of life but cannot destroy the soul" ([Mt 10:28](#)).
3. "Do not be afraid of anything" ([Mt 10:31](#)).
4. "Fear Him Who can destroy both body and soul in Gehenna" ([Mt 10:28](#)).

We are fearless of men because we have the fear of the Lord ([Sir 34:14](#)). The fear of the Lord is not only the beginning of wisdom ([Ps 111:10](#)) but also of faith, which leads to love. When love is complete, it casts out all fear ([1 Jn 4:18](#)). Thus, the grace of fearlessness comes from fear of the Lord, faith, and love.

The Lord has not only commanded us to be fearless of men but has shown us how He will give us the grace of fearlessness. We must cooperate by:

- renewing our Confirmations in which we received the fear of the Lord (see [Is 11:2-3](#)),
- growing in faith through hearing God in His Word ([Rm 10:17](#)), and
- growing in love through purifying ourselves "by obedience to the truth" ([1 Pt 1:22](#)).

Be fearless in Christ.

**Prayer:** Father, make me miraculously courageous.

**Promise:** "If by the offense of the one man all died, much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound for all." —Rm 5:15

**Praise:** Praise You, Jesus, Son of God, love incarnate, "the Resurrection and the Life" (Jn 11:25).

### THE REAL PRESENCE OF JESUS CHRIST IN THE SACRAMENT OF THE EUCHARIST: BASIC QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

#### 1. **Why does Jesus give himself to us as food and drink?**

Jesus gives himself to us in the Eucharist as spiritual nourishment because he loves us. God's whole plan for our salvation is directed to our participation in the life of the Trinity, the communion of Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Our sharing in this life begins with our Baptism, when by the power of the Holy Spirit we are joined to Christ, thus becoming adopted sons and daughters of the Father. It is strengthened and increased in Confirmation. It is nourished and deepened through our participation in the Eucharist. By eating the Body and drinking the Blood of Christ in the Eucharist we become united to the person of Christ through his humanity. "Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him" (Jn 6:56). In being united to the humanity of Christ we are at the same time united to his divinity. Our mortal and corruptible natures are transformed by being joined to the source of life. "Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me" (Jn 6:57). By being united to Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit dwelling in us, we are drawn up into the eternal relationship of love among the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. As Jesus is the eternal Son of God by nature, so we become sons and daughters of God by adoption through the sacrament of Baptism. Through the sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation (Chrismation), we are temples of the Holy Spirit, who dwells in us, and by his indwelling we are made holy by the gift of sanctifying grace. The ultimate promise of the Gospel is that we will share in the life of the Holy Trinity. The Fathers of the Church called this participation in the divine life "divinization" (*theosis*). In this we see that God does not merely send us good things from on high; instead, we are brought up into the inner life of God, the communion among the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. In the celebration of the Eucharist (which means "thanksgiving") we give praise and glory to God for this sublime gift.

## LA PRESENCIA REAL DE JESUCRISTO EN EL SACRAMENTO DE LA EUCARISTÍA PREGUNTAS BÁSICAS Y RESPUESTAS

### CONTINUACIÓN...

Cristo no tiene que dejar su lugar en el cielo para estar con nosotros. Nosotros, más bien, participamos de la liturgia celestial en la que Cristo intercede eternamente por nosotros y presenta su sacrificio al Padre, y en la que los ángeles y santos glorifican constantemente a Dios y dan gracias por todos sus dones: "Al que está sentado en el trono y al Cordero, la alabanza, el honor, la gloria y el poder, por los siglos de los siglos" (Ap 5, 13). Como indica el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, "Por la celebración eucarística nos unimos ya a la liturgia del cielo y anticipamos la vida eterna cuando Dios será todo en todos" (no. 1326). La proclamación del "Sanctus", "Santo, Santo, Santo es el Señor. . .", es la canción de los ángeles que están en la presencia de Dios (Is 6, 3). Cuando en la Eucaristía proclamamos el "Sanctus", hacemos eco en la tierra de la canción con la que los ángeles adoran a Dios en el cielo. En la celebración eucarística no recordamos simplemente un acontecimiento de la historia, sino que, mediante la acción misteriosa del Espíritu Santo en la celebración eucarística, el Misterio Pascual del Señor se hace presente y se actualiza a su Esposa la Iglesia. Asimismo, en la actualización eucarística del eterno sacrificio de Cristo ante el Padre, nosotros no somos simples espectadores. El sacerdote y la comunidad de fieles están activos de maneras diferentes en el sacrificio eucarístico. El sacerdote ordenado, de pie ante el altar, representa a Cristo como cabeza de la Iglesia. Todos los bautizados, como miembros del Cuerpo de Cristo, participan del sacerdocio del Salvador, como sacerdote y víctima a la vez. La Eucaristía es también el sacrificio de la Iglesia. La Iglesia, Cuerpo y Esposa de Cristo, participa en la ofrenda sacrificial de su Cabeza y Esposo. En la Eucaristía el sacrificio de Cristo se convierte en el sacrificio de los miembros de su Cuerpo que unidos a Cristo forman una sola ofrenda sacrificial (cf. Catecismo, no. 1368). Como el sacrificio de Cristo, se hace presente de manera sacramental, unidos a Cristo, nosotros nos ofrecemos como sacrificio al Padre. "La Iglesia, al desempeñar la función de sacerdote y víctima juntamente con Cristo, ofrece toda entera el sacrificio de la misa, y toda entera se ofrece en él" (Mysterium Fidei, no. 31; cf. Lumen Gentium, no. 11).

Jesús nos da al menos cuatro mandamientos en la lectura del Evangelio de hoy:

1. "No les teman" (Mt 10:26).

3. "No teman entonces, porque valen más" (Mt 10:31).
4. "Teman más bien a aquel que puede arrojar el alma y el cuerpo a la Gehena" (Mt 10:28).

No nos intimidan los hombres porque tenemos el temor del Señor (Eclo 34:14). El temor del Señor no solo es el principio de la sabiduría (Sal 111:10), sino también de la fe, que conduce al amor. Cuando el amor es perfecto elimina el temor (1 Jn 4:18). Por lo tanto, la gracia de la intrepidez viene del temor del Señor, de la fe y del amor.
